


Admittedly, I'm a "political junky" by nature. This leaves me in a never ending search for answers to the many


Even if we consider ourselves to be faithful, Bible-believing Christians, we frequently delude ourselves into think-

FARMAGEDDON Exposes Government Intervention in our Food Supply

id you know that in certain states it is illegal to sell unpasteurized milk to eager customers, despite its several health benefits as attested to by many health professionals? Are you aware that sellers of raw milk must be licensed and are strictly regulated, and that the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has actually raided small farms that sell it? Have you heard that

artisanal cheese-makers are quietly being shut down all over the country? In short, under the guise of "health and safety", the U. S. government is rapidly restricting our food choices, and many are asking why.

Last November, at a school in her hometown of Concord, MA, Kristin Canty presided over a Q&A following an evening showing of her new, 90 minute DVD entitled *Farmageddon*, which attempts to pin-

point some answers. Viewers came away impressed not only with the importance of the film's goal, to raise awareness about the food we eat and how our freedoms to choose it are fast disappearing, but also with its shocking expose of our government's intrusion into the food chain. Farmageddon explores the phenomenon of why small family farms providing safe, healthful foods to their communities have

been forced by agents of government bureaucracies to stop doing so.

of the camera time to candidates the networks favor. The bias is blatant when USA TODAY runs two pictured articles





on Todd said he does not ever remember *not* being in church. He firmly believes that it is his Uncle Sam that was the impetus for his desire to serve God throughout his life. Pastor Sam Stricklin was the first to move east, to Warwick, RI where he established the First Baptist Church.

Todd's father worked for the USDA and Todd said that he was on the "fast track," frequently moving the family as his responsibilities grew and his promotions occurred. Todd believes that the many moves may have contributed to him being a mischievous boy, inattentive in school and often in trouble for "silly" things.

When his father transferred to Washington, DC Todd attended a Christian high school and due to the accelerated Christian education curriculum he received his high school diploma at age sixteen. He began at Bob Jones University but was asked to leave after his first year-still the mischievous, trouble maker. He returned and became proficient at youth and music. He later attended Gardner-Webb University in North Carolina where he achieved a degree in Bible in

After graduating, Todd worked at some secular jobs for a little while. Around Easter in 1988, his Uncle Sam came to visit and later called Todd to tell him that First Baptist Christian School had a teaching position open and he was looking for someone like Todd, a strong believer, who was attempting to live the way he had been taught. Todd made the move. He loved his

role at the school; he taught Bible, history, basic math and coaching and remained there for about 9 years.

It was at First Baptist that he met his wife Maureen whose family were "charter members" of the church. They married in June 1990 and their first son was born one year later. They have three

children now: Trevor, Torrey, and Alexandria.

First Baptist Church hosted missionary conferences each year, always four weekends in a row. Over time, Todd began to think, "Someday I will be a missionary." Then, each time he would hear missionaries speak he would quietly pray: "Father, do you want me to go there?" Maureen had never ventured farther from RI than Massachusetts, what a challenge and change it would be for them all if they were to live elsewhere.

Todd and Maureen were given the opportunity to lead a small team on a mission trip to Costa Rico in




1992. Todd said that it is common for missionaries to want to stay at the first place they go believing it to be a calling from God. On the border, Nicaragua was under military occupation with much unrest there. As their plane left the ground, looking down Todd said that Nicaragua looked like one big "dust bowl" and promised Maureen; "Don't worry honey, I will never bring you to a place like this."

In 1995, they made a public confession to enter the mission field. Not knowing a word of Spanish, Todd went to Nicaragua on a survey trip. On the day he was leaving Nicaragua, at the top of the stairs and

about to enter the aircraft he looked back and thought to himself, "God broke my heart." When he got home he informed Maureen, "This 'is' where He wants to send us!"

> there. He said that if people look back and say "Oh, what a man of faith Todd Stricklin is; it had nothing to do with that. I was saying the Christian things, the things that I should say. I used to say, Well, God can do anything He wants to do; if He wants to give us a building, He'll give us a building." Pastor Todd then exclaimed,

"I wasn't saying it because I really thought that He would!"

The church had its sights set on a Masonic Hall in East Greenwich. Days from signing the papers after the negotiations were finished; they were only waiting for an evaluation on what it would cost to get the renovations done. They loved the area and the building had a lot of potential. Then a call came from Shawomet Baptist Church asking if Narragansett Bay would be interested in the property.

Some wonder why we bother to serve fresh buttered rolls with our stew. They spent some time prodding Pastor Todd, asking about the beliefs of his church and their response was "We don't agree on some of this stuff but we are convinced that you are who God wants us to give this building to."

Pastor Todd said "over the years I had preached about all of the incredible things that God has done. All these years that I have been saying God can do whatever He wants to, I believed that. And I have heard incredible stories of what He had done for others, but it was always me telling someone else's story; God did this for soand-so then all of a sudden we're living it!"


"It is overwhelming every time I tell the story," he said. We sense a tremendous responsibility now for what God wants us to do here. We have been at the new location since

healthful food for her four children when she stumbled upon the realization that her access to certain foods was being threatened. She began to discover numerous policies favoring agribusiness and factory farms as opposed to small family-operated farms selling fresh foods to their communities. She found that the real source of food safety problems, most often the industrial food chain -- is largely disregarded, while policy makers and regulators prefer implementing and enforcing solutions that target and often drive out of business small farms with proven records of producing safe, healthful food. Small businesses frequently buckle under the crushing weight of government regulations and over-reaching enforcement actions, sometimes involving violence.

Farmageddon highlights the urgency of farmers and consumers alike to act to preserve individuals' rights to access the foods they want to eat, and farmers' rights to produce them safely, free of unreasonably burdensome regulations. As freedom to make these choices is removed, there is a growing movement of people using their tax dollars and votes to protect and preserve the dwindling number of small family farms struggling to

Kristin Canty's decision to make Farmageddon was a reaction to the difficulty she had encountered while looking for relief for her four year old son, Charlie. Suf-

fering from asthma and horrible allergies to just about everything, Charlie was well acquainted with "many drugs, epi-pens, asthma inhalers, beds wrapped in plastic, and Hepa filters", Kristin says. But the drugs had worrisome side effects, and Charlie was not improving. While researching for answers, Kristin learned that some people's allergies had subsided when they drank raw milk directly from grass-fed cows. The explanation was that unpasteurized milk contains healthy bacteria and enzymes missing in so many of our foods today. Kristin cautiously began to give her son raw milk. Eventually Charlie's allergies and asthma diminished, and he was fully cured.

Kristin's initial success inspired her to introduce her family to more healthful foods. She became convinced to eliminate, as much as possible, eating factory-farmed foods tainted by antibiotics, steroids, and genetically modified (GMO) grains. Instead, she hunted for sources of food from smaller, grass-fed, organic farms. By joining a food co-op, the Cantys began sharing resources needed to procure milk, meat, vegetables and eggs from local farms, and have them delivered.

But one day, Kristin heard that Manna Storehouse, a food co-op in LaGrange, OH, had been raided. It disturbed her greatly to learn that armed agents, authorized by the OH Department of Agriculture, had entered a private home and held eight children and their parents at gunpoint for six hours while ransacking their house, seizing their cell phones, personal food, and food from their co-op. Later Kristin discovered that more farms and co-ops had also been raided simply for selling food their customers wanted to buy.

Hoping to get to the bottom of these stories, Kristin began digging and delving. She found that the main reason for many of the raids is to crack down on selling raw milk. The USDA, in the document "Healthy People 2020", stated they intend to "increase the number of states that have prohibited sale or distribution of unpasteurized dairy products." This obviously makes it harder for people to obtain desired raw dairy products. Regardless of the health benefits of drinking raw milk, generally accepted as scientifically proven, many government agencies claim it is too dangerous to drink. Kristin says, "They fail to make a distinction between milk that is meant for pasteurization (from factory farms that are not concerned with cleanliness and which feed grains,

antibiotics, and steroids to their cows) and milk from grass fed, pasture rotated cows, intended to be consumed raw."

Kristin has come to believe that the raids are less about raw milk than, as in the case of the OH Co-op, about control of the food retail system.

Manna Storehouse, a private coop, was formed by Jackie Stowers and her friends when they found that many organic farms had no means to get their goods to market. The mothers bought meat, eggs, and vegetables from the farms, shared the pick-up responsibilities, and once a week, everyone came to Jackie's house to pick up the food. When the OH Department of Agriculture learned of it, they raided them. Since then, such raids have increased, yet no one has ever been made sick by these foods. There were zero complaints about any of those businesses. They were all successful farms and co-ops with happy and healthy members and customers.

That explains why Kristin Canty set out to tell this story, to allow honest farmers using centuries old farming practices to tell their side of the story. Rather than trying to convince people to drink raw milk or eat grass-fed beef, the purpose of Kristin's film is to provide an argument for allowing people who want to make those choices to do so. Hopefully, exposing how the government is harassing small farmers, private food buying clubs, and co-ops will lead to restoring our freedom to choose what foods to buy, while reducing government interference. Kristin believes that until then, we are really not free. Many true stories, told in their own words by the people involved, are related in Farmageddon. Numerous small family farmers in VT, NY, PA, OH, and GA, are among many who tell how they were subjected to serious abuses by the government. Their stories are only representative of those happening to small farmers

throughout America. The follow-

In 2000, an inept and corrupt USDA targeted for BSE (Mad Cow Disease) testing, the healthy flock of sheep owned by Larry

> and Linda Faillace, artisanal farmers and cheesemakers in Mad River Valley, **VT**. This despite the fact that BSE does not exist in sheep! Nevertheless, although extensive testing showed no contamination whatever, the sheep were subsequently confiscated and

destroyed. Later, Linda Faillace wrote a book recounting their incredible experiences with the USDA, and tells of filing a lawsuit in which the many misdeeds against them were enumerated and documented. These included destruction of evidence, suppression of test results, extensive undercover surveillance, and misleading and false statements given to the general public and their elected officials. See Mad Sheep: The True Story Behind the USDA's War on a Family Farm (Chelsea Green Publishing).

In 2008, the Newville, **PA** farm of dairyman Mark Nolt, a Wenger (Horse and Buggy) Mennonite, was raided three times, resulting in the confiscation of more than \$65,000 worth of fresh food. Mr. Nolt, a man of great integrity, lacked a permit to sell raw milk only because he had turned it back in after noting that it did not cover all of the products he sold, for he wished to deal honestly with the government. On 4/25/08, in a Gestapo-like raid, six state troopers and a man with the PA Department of Agriculture trespassed onto and removed Mr. Nolt from his own property, then stole \$20,000 - \$25,000 worth of his product and equipment. When finally released by the government,





The "permitting" issue, supposedly for reasons of food safety, seems somewhat contradicted by how sellers of raw milk must compete with sellers of corporate milk, which is pasteurized and often comes from cows injected with a drug, genetically engineered bovine growth hormone (rBGH). Monsanto's rBGH was the first genetically engineered product ever, and was approved by the FDA during the Clinton administration, after Monsanto employees were appointed to run the FDA. In 1994, employees at the FDA wrote an anonymous (since they feared retribution) letter to Congress revealing that Dr. Margaret Miller, the author of the FDA's opinion on why milk from rBGH-treated cows should not be labeled, formerly worked for the Monsanto company as a researcher on rBGH.

However, according to the conclusion of a study released around that time, "...milk from cows injected with [rBGH] increases risks of breast and colon cancers in humans." Samuel Epstein, M. D., Professor of Environmental Medicine, declared "The FDA and Monsanto have a lot to answer for. Given the cancer risks, and other health concerns, why is rBGH milk still on the market?" (Ever since 1986, independent scientists





NEA, Liberal Groups Release National Sex-Ed Standards

(WNS)—Kindergarten through second grade. That's the grade at which the National Education Association (NEA), the Future of Sex Education Initiative and a coalition of sex-ed groups want children to start learning the names of body parts and alternative family structures. The recommendations are outlined in the National Sexuality Education Standards released on Monday to school districts nationwide. Although they are non-binding, having the weight of the NEA behind the recommendations could give them the gravitas needed to quickly — and quietly — be implemented around the country.

Supreme Court Issues Unanimous Decision in **Church Hiring Case**

(WNS)--In one of the clearest rulings for religious freedom in years, the U.S. Supreme Court unanimously decided that courts may not intervene in church hiring decisions, protecting the "ministerial exception" that the **Equal Employment Opportunity** Commission sought to eliminate in Hosanna-Tabor Evangelical Lutheran Church and School v. EEOC. "[T]he authority to select and control who will minister to the faithful is the church's alone," Chief Justice John Roberts wrote in the court's opinion. Justices Clarence Thomas, Samuel Alito, and Elena Kagan wrote separate concurring opinions that said the ministerial exception should be even broader than Roberts allowed in his opinion. "It was a strong rebuke to the extreme position taken by the Obama administration," said Luke Goodrich of the Becket Fund for Religious Liberty, who served as counsel to the church in the case. "One of the biggest things is it's unanimously decided, which nobody was predicting and is a really big deal. ... It's a great day for religious

New Lawsuit Over **Conscience Protections**

(WNS)--An evangelical college has sued the federal government over the thin conscience protections in the national healthcare law. The same day the school filed the suit, an array of evangelical leaders sent another letter to the White House contesting the current conscience protections and urging President Obama to expand those protections. Colorado Christian University filed the lawsuit in January contesting the constitutionality of the healthcare law, which says employers must provide coverage for contraceptives, including abortifacients like Plan B and Ella, drugs that can prevent an embryo from implanting in the womb. The law allows an exemption from that rule for a religious employer only if the organization primarily employs and serves the same religion, and has as its main purpose the "inculcation of religious values," which essentially only covers churches. Colorado Christian is a nondenominational school in Lakewood, Colo., with about 4,200 students, and it does not expect it would fall under the religious exemption.

New Hampshire House Defunds Planned Parenthood

(WNS)--The New Hampshire House of Representatives voted 207-147 on Jan. 18 to pass a bill stripping state funding of Planned Parenthood and any other group performing elective abortions. The 60-vote majority was plenty to pass HB 228 on to the state Senate, but not enough to override a potential veto from Gov. John Lynch.

"The majority of people agree that, regardless of individual beliefs, taxpayers should not be forced to contribute to the largest abortion provider in American when so many are diametrically religiously and morally opposed to the practice of abortions," House Speaker Bill O'Brien said.

The pro-life Susan B. Anthony List applauded legislators' decision, as did the Alliance Defense Fund.

"Every innocent life deserves to be protected. Taxpayer dollars should go toward helping and caring for the most vulnerable Americans, not killing them," said ADF Senior Counsel Mike Norton. "New Hampshire taxpayers should not be forced to fund abortions."

Last October, the House Health and Human Services Committee consisting of 13 Republicans and five Democrats - voted

12-5 to kill the bill on the House floor. O'Brien urged legislators to ignore that report and support the bill instead.

"Tebow Bills" **Abound**

(WNS)--Denver Broncos quarterback Tim Tebow's success on the football field hasn't just gotten the attention of every sportswriter in the country or sparked the use of a new verb ("Tebowing") this year. If some legislators have their way, it could pave a whole new avenue for homeschoolers to be able to play on organized sports teams at their local public schools.

Tebow, now 24, grew up in Florida - one of 24 states with "equal access" laws that allow homeschooled students to participate in extracurricular activities at their local public high schools. But in recent years, at least three others - Alabama, Arkansas and Kentucky - have introduced legislation specifically named after Tebow to have the same privilege. In Virginia Gov. Bob McDonnell said he'd support similar legislation introduced there. "Homeschool parents pay taxes like everybody else," he said. "It's just fair."

The Battle of New York

(WNS)--Police on Jan. 12 arrested 43 New York City pastors and lay people who were protesting the city's ban on church use of public schools for worship services. The ban is scheduled to go into effect on Feb. 12.

The arrests came after more than 200 persons gathered in the rain outside a Bronx public school where Mayor Michael Bloomberg was giving his State of the City address. After singing songs and cheering speeches, protesters walked out in orderly groups of five to eight to kneel in front of barricades and pray. Police warned them to leave and then made arrests on charges of disorderly conduct.

The New York Board of Education wants to ban religious use of schools on Sunday mornings or at other times the schools are otherwise unused—even though the churches rent the space, dropping an estimated several million dollars per year into the city cashbox. If the ban prevails, more than 150 congregations will have to move to other meeting space starting next month—and that's hard to find in New York City.

One week before the large protest, police arrested New York City Councilman and pastor Fernando

Cabrera, pastor Bill Devlin, and five others on charges of "criminal trespassing." Their alleged trespass was kneeling and singing two hymns outside the doors of the New York City Law Department. Police held them in custody for three hours.

The following day, Jan. 6, the New York Housing Authorities reversed its position to evict churches that meet inside community centers.

Board of Education officials stuck with their ban, though, saying it will protect the minds of "impressionable youth."

On Jan. 9 more than 100 persons from different ethnic, income, and denominational backgrounds held a prayer meeting at Calvary Baptist Church in Midtown Manhattan. The prayer event concluded a citywide week of fasting and prayer on behalf of pastors and council members who are working

to overturn the ban.

Bronx Pastor Dimas Salberrios said the ban would be particularly harmful in poorer communities: Churches in boroughs like Queens

and the Bronx successfully battle crime and poverty, and uprooting them is "destructive." He pointed to lower crime rates, help for the poor and homeless, and educational assistance for children as examples of what churches contribute.

The Bronx pastor, who has battled homicides in his own neighborhood and been held at gunpoint six times, has been on a hunger strike since Jan. 1 and says he won't eat until the ban is overturned.

Attempts at a legislative fix are underway. New York Assemblyman Nelson Castro has introduced Bill A08800, which would allow "the use of school buildings and school sites for religious meetings and worship when not in use for school purposes or when such service or worship is deemed not disruptive of normal school operations."

Ron Paul Introduces Legislation to Strike NDAA's Unconstitutional Section 1021

(Infowars.com) Rep. Ron Paul left the campaign trail last week to speak on the House floor about the National Defense Authorization Act, which was signed into law on the first day of the new year by Obama.

Paul introduced legislation to strike the NDAA's Section 1021, the discretionary detention provision authorizing the President to detain persons accused by the government of supporting terrorism.

Ron Paul has serious reservations despite Obama's issuing a signing statement declaring that he will not use the law to detain Americans. In December, Paul said the bill will accelerate the country's "slip into tyranny" and virtually assures "our descent into totalitarianism."

The Texas congressman and presidential candidate said on Wednesday the bill "provides for the possibility of the U.S. military acting as a kind of police force on U.S. soil, apprehending terror suspects, including Americans, and whisk-

ing them off to an undisclosed location indefinitely."

He then criticized his fellow lawmakers. "Sadly, too many of my colleagues are too willing to undermine our constitution to support such outrageous legislation. One senator even said, about American citizens being picked up under this section of the NDAA, 'When they say 'I want my lawyer,' you tell them, 'Shut up. You don't get a lawyer."

"Is this acceptable in someone who has taken an oath to uphold the constitution?" Paul asked.

The Senator Paul left unnamed is Lindsey Graham (R-S.C.). Graham has compared the war on terror to the Second World War and believes suspected enemies should be stripped of constitutional protections. The so-called war on terror - including the conflicts in Afghanistan, Iraq and Pakistan - was not declared by Congress. Article 1, Section 8 of the Constitution makes it clear only Congress can declare war and the president is then authorized to wage it.

Member of Kuwaiti royal family embraces Christ

IRAN (ANS) -- A Kuwaiti royal prince has become a believer in Jesus Christ and says that if he is killed because of an audio recording he made about his decision, he believes he will meet Christ face-to-face.

According to www.Mohabatnews. com, the Iranian Christian News Agency, Al-haqiqa, a Christian Arabic satellite T.V. station, which broadcasts Christian programs, played an audio file which it attributed to a Kuwaiti prince called "Abdollah Al-sabah."

This Kuwaiti prince announced, "First of all, I totally agree with the distribution of this audio file and I now declare that if they kill me because of this audio file, then I'll go into the presence of Jesus Christ and be with him for all eternity."

The T.V. channel claimed that Prince Abdollah Al-sabah comes

from a Kuwaiti royal family which currently governs the country. The channel also said that the prince recently denounced his Islamic faith and became a Christian.

The prince added: "I'm satisfied with whatever they do to me,

because the truth in the Bible has guided me to the right way."

Regarding the Islamic groups who have recently gained power in Egypt, this Kuwaiti prince also

stated, "Islamic communities have always wanted to attack in different parts of the world, but God has preserved the world and still protects it. This is why we have recently seen disagreements appearing among Islamic groups who are now fighting with each other. They are about to divide further into different groups.

Mohabat News says this piece

of news made headlines briefly on Arabic newswires and also in the Iranian government run news agency. Some independent Shiite websites contradicted this report and quoted another Kuwaiti prince, Azbi Al-sabah as saying, "There is no one in the Kuwaiti royal family

by that name."

Kuwait is a Middle Eastern country, neighboring Iraq, Saudi Arabia and Iran across the Persian Gulf. Its capital city is also called Kuwait.

Islam is the official and dominant religion in Kuwait, and almost the entire population is Muslim.

North Korea's leader will not last long, says Kim Jong-un's brother

BELJING, CHINA (ANS) -- "The eldest son of North Korea's late leader Kim Jong-il has predicted the regime would soon fail, with or without reforms, according to a new book that the author says is based on emails and interviews with Kim Jong-nam."

This extraordinary statement was made in a story by Jonathan Watts and Tania Branigan in Beijing for the UK-based newspaper, The Guardian (www.guardian.co.uk).

The journalists said that the book says that Kim Jong-nam - who has never met the new leader, his halfbrother Kim Jong-un - described the dynastic succession as "a joke to the outside world", and said even his father had originally opposed the hereditary transfer of power.

"The Kim Jong-un regime will not last long," Kim Jong-nam is said to have written, forecasting a power struggle. "Without reforms, North Korea will collapse, and when such changes take place the regime will collapse."

Kim Jong-nam added: "I think we will see valuable time lost as the regime sits idle fretting over whether it should pursue reforms or stick to the present political structure."

The journalists went on to say that the claims emerge in a book by Yoji Gomi, a journalist with Tokyo Shimbun, who said he exchanged emails with Kim Jongnam over seven years. The date of the remarks on the regime is

Gomi, who lived for years in Seoul and Beijing, said he met Kim three times in total, once in 2004 and twice in 2011.

"He gave me a very good impression. He's very gentle and friendly," Gomi said.

"We exchanged emails over some time and when I suggested compiling our exchanges as a book, he agreed. At first he wanted publication to be delayed, but when I said we ought to go ahead because of everything that is happening in

offered relatively outspoken if brief remarks on the North to journalists who have tracked him down, but these reported messages go much further. Experts on North Korea cautioned that it was impossible to verify the details unless or until Kim Jong-nam confirmed he had written the emails."

They concluded by saying that in one message, Kim Jong-nam remarked: "I'm concerned how

Only time will tell if this turn out to be true. In the meantime, let us continue to pray for the many suffering Christians in North Korea who are in the numerous concentration camps there. Nigerian Crisis

Six Nigerian journalists make their way to Uganda despite a nationwide strike in their home country threatening air travel

(WNS)--Labor unions initiated what local newspapers have called "an industrial action" against the Nigerian government over the removal of fuel subsidies earlier this month. Fueling public anger, President Goodluck Jonathan gave Nigerians only one week's notice that the subsidies would be lifted resulting in a 150 percent increase in fuel prices.

Ending the subsidy, which kept fuel prices artificially low, prompted mass demonstrations across the country starting a week ago. Labor unions followed, announcing work stoppages that halted air traffic and public transportation.

"Action embarked upon by workers in Nigeria has literally shut down the country," said Emmanuel Adeniyi, a reporter for the Nigerian Tribune who made it to a World Journalism Institute (WJI) conference in Kampala—a journey of over 3,000 miles—despite the

cancellation of most commercial flights. Adeniyi said that the journalists also worried that government-imposed curfews to curb demonstrations could make travel difficult. But a brief window of movement opened over the weekend while the Jonathan government and labor unions negotiated ways to end the crisis.

The crisis has come at the same time that the militant Islamic group Boko Haram has stepped up attacks against Christian groups, including bombings and shootings that have killed more than 100 since Christmas Day. Jonathan has accused the militants of using the street demonstrations to foment chaos and lawlessness.

On Monday, the unions suspended their nationwide strike just hours after Jonathan partially reinstated the subsidies. Union leaders claimed victory in the dispute, as they will be able to guide the country's policy on fuel subsidies in the future.

Earlier, when it had appeared that the negotiations had stalled, demonstrators again took the streets. But this time the government responded by sending security forces in response. In Lagos, the capital, and Kano, the country's second largest city, tanks barricaded key intersections where last week thousands had demonstrated. Soldiers in Lagos fired live rounds of ammunition over a crowd of several hundred demonstrators. The journalists attending the Kampala conference believe the military's presence could lead to violent confrontations in Africa's most populous nation and its second largest economy.

Nigeria exports more than 2 million barrels of crude oil daily, most of it to the United States. Those U.S. imports amount to 10 percent of the country's petroleum consumption. But Nigeria's oil industry, Africa's largest, is riddled with broken infrastructure and corruption that has left it unable to refine its own crude: Nigeria actually imports 70 percent of the refined oil it needs for consumption. According to the government, fuel importers benefit most from subsidies, and use the subsidies to fix prices; the government also argues that money saved by ending subsidies could be used to shore up refineries, roads, and other infrastructure.

But the doubling of prices brought on by the end of subsidies fell hard on Nigerians, the majority of whom live on about \$2 per day. "The removal changes everything," said Nkechi Onyedika, a reporter for The Guardian who lives in Lagos and is attending the Uganda conference. Prices of food along with many other goods and all forms of transportation rose dramatically as a result of the government action, she said.

But the journalists also arrived in a restive Uganda, where shopkeepers in Kampala were entering their third day of strikes over spiraling interest rates. Their grievances stem from a central bank decision to raise rates, leading most commercial banks in Uganda's capital to as much as double interest rates on some business loans, and retroactively.

Shops, stores, shopping malls,

restaurants and some factories in Kampala and several other Ugandan cities closed starting Jan. 11. But by Monday they relented after a meeting with Ugandan President Yoweri Museveni: "We have called off the strike but we shall continue the fight," said business leader Evaristo Kayondo.

Many African nations are confronting inflation and delayed effects from the recent global recession, while at the same time there is a heightened awareness of the power of street action following the Arab Spring revolts in the Middle East and North Africa. The Nigerian journalists attending the two-week conference in Uganda-which includes 18 journalists from nine African nations—hope that business entities and governments will continue to talk to one another long enough for them to return home.

More than 75 percent of all 'honey' sold in grocery stores contains no honey at all

(NaturalNews) Just because those cute little bear-shaped bottles at the grocery store say "honey" on them does not necessarily mean that they actually contain honey. A comprehensive investigation conducted by Food Safety News (FSN) has found that the vast majority of so-called honey products sold

at grocery stores, big box stores, drug stores, and restaurants do not contain any pollen, which means they are not real honey.



For the investigation, Vaughn Bryant, one of the nation's leading melissopalynologists, or experts in identifying pollen in honey, and director of the Palynology Research Laboratory at Texas A&M University, evaluated more than 60 products labeled as "honey" that had been purchased by FSN from ten states and the District of Columbia.

Bryant found that 76 percent of "honey" samples purchased from major grocery store chains like Kroger and Safeway, and 77 percent of samples purchased from big box chains like Sam's Club and Wal-Mart, did not contain any pollen. Even worse were "honey" samples taken from drug stores like Walgreens and CVS, and fast food restaurants like McDonald's and KFC, 100 percent of which were found to contain not a trace of pollen.

So what is all this phony honey made of? It is difficult to say for sure, as pollen is the key to verifying that honey is real. According to FSN, much of this imposter honey is more likely being secretly imported from China, and may

even be contaminated with antibiotic drugs and other foreign materials.

According to FSN, the lack of pollen in most conventional "honey" products is due to these products having been ultra-filtered. This means that they have been intensely heated, forced through

> extremely tiny filters, and potentially even watered down or adulterated in some way prior to hitting store shelves.

The US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) holds the position that any so-called honey products that have been ultra-filtered are not actually honey. But the agency refuses to do anything to stop this influx of illegitimate "honey" from flooding the North American market. It also continues to stonewall all petitions to establish a national regulatory standard for verifying the integrity of honey.

Assuming that there is any real honey at all in the phony honey products tested by FSN, the removal of pollen and other delicate materials via ultra-filtering renders them medicinally dead. Raw honey is a health-promoting food that can help alleviate stomach problems, anemia, allergies, and other health conditions. Ultra-filtered honey is nothing more than a health-destroying processed sugar in the same vein as white table sugar or high fructose corn syrup.

The good news is that all of the honey products FSN tested from farmers markets, food cooperatives, and "natural" stores like Trader Joe's and Whole Foods, were found to contain pollen and a full array of antioxidants and other nutrients. Local beekeepers are another great source of obtaining raw, unprocessed, real honey.

EPA targets families that generate heat off the grid using traditional wood-burning stoves

FDA violates law by refusing to ban antibiotics from use in animal feed

(NaturalNews) Earlier in the year, several concerned groups sued the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for failing to address the issue of antibiotic use in animal feed. Though numerous studies have found that adding antibiotics to animal feed undeniably causes antibiotic resistance, including an FDA study from 1977, the agency insists that banning the practice is too difficult.

The Environmental Defense Fund (EDF), the Center for Science in the Public Interest (CSPI), the Food Animal Concerns Trust (FACT), and the Union of Concerned Scientists (UCS) all agree that using penicillin and tetracyclines (antibiotics used to treat humans) in animal feed to bulk animals up and cause them grow faster is an unacceptable threat to public health. But the FDA apparently does not agree, as it claims that implementing any sort of ban

will be "too expensive and resource intensive," according to a FACT press release.

The FDA stated in its response to the lawsuit that, rather than forcibly restrict the use of antibiotics, the agency will instead allow drug companies to continue "selfregulating" themselves. In other words, it is just more business as usual at the taxpayer-funded Big Pharma agency that looks out for special interests rather than the interests of the people.

"Instead of adhering to its mission to protect consumers, the FDA is waiting for the drug companies to voluntarily do what the agency is legally mandated to do," said FACT's Public Health Program Director Steven Roach. "There is absolutely no reason to believe that drug companies will voluntarily reduce sales of antibiotics and act against their own finan-

cial self-interest. Without reductions in antibiotics used it is impossible for there to

be any public health benefit."

It only makes sense that the agency tasked with protecting public health would be expected to step up to the plate and restrict antibiotic use in animals except in cases of actual illness. But the FDA works for a different boss. and few in the American public seem to care that this rogue traitor continues to pad its pockets at the expense of their health.

Not only do antibiotics cause animals to become obese and ill, but they also cause serious health problems in those that eat meat produced from such animals. The US Department of Agriculture (USDA) even admitted back in 2010 that antibiotic use in livestock is a serious threat to human health.

CDC admits not a single person has died from consuming raw milk products in 11 years

(NaturalNews) The US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) refuses to acknowledge that, based on all available statistics, raw milk produced on clean, small-scale farms is actually far safer than pasteurized milk from factory farms. But the agency did admit

earlier this year, after being pressed and warned of a potential Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request if it failed to comply, that not a single person has died from raw milk consumption in over a decade.

This may come as a shock to some who, because of all the propaganda

about the alleged dangers of raw milk, are convinced otherwise, but it is true -- one of the two deaths often cited by the CDC as evidence that raw milk is dangerous was actually linked to the consumption of raw queso fresco

> cheese, which is currently outlawed by the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA). And the other is likely linked to an adulterated raw milk product as well, rather than to raw milk.

After repeatedly petitioning the CDC for clarification about its questionable raw milk sta-

tistics and getting nowhere, Mark McAfee, owner of Organic Pastures Dairy Company (OPDC) in California, finally threatened to file a FOIA request to get to the truth. Shortly thereafter, he received a response from an unidentified official at the CDC's information office explaining that the one "raw

milk" death that occurred between 1998 and 2008 was actually linked to illegal raw queso fresco cheese.

The agency has not yet provided details about the other death, but it is likely that it, too, was linked to some adulterated raw milk product rather than to raw milk itself. If and when the agency finally fesses up to the truth about that case, it will also be inadvertently admitting that it has lied to the public for many years about the nature of raw milk.

The CDC's continual avoidance of talking about the much worse dangers associated with pasteurized milk further illustrates its raw milk bias. In 2006 alone, there were at least 1,300 people who got sick from pasteurized milk just in California -- and yet the CDC only talks about the roughly 39 reported illnesses every year in the Golden State that are alleged, but not necessarily proven to be, linked to raw milk.

Throughout history, civilizations have relied on the burning of wood to cook food, warm water, and heat places of dwelling. After all, trees are an abundant and renewable source of wood, which means that the costs associated with obtaining energy and heat from burning wood are minimal. This, of course, is why many cash-strapped folks today are turning to wood-burning stoves rather than their local utilities.

But the EPA is now expressing concern about the 80 percentor-so of wood stove users that still rely on non-EPA approved models. Most of the wood stoves manufactured before 1990 do not contain the EPA's certification stamp of approval which, in the eyes of the agency, means they are an unnecessary contributor of excess environmental pollution.

EPA-approved models can still emit excess smoke just like the others, and may not necessarily provide any pollution-reducing benefits at all. Because of

their altered designs, many of the new EPA-approved models do not work as well as the older models, either, especially when used in severely-cold weather (www. energybulletin.net/51578).

Most wood-burning stove companies in the US actually went out of business shortly after the EPA established its original certification requirements for wood stoves back in the 1990s. Many

This is debatable, of course, as of the companies simply could not develop a complying product that actually worked. Today, the EPA is once again revisiting these New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) guidelines in order to push

> even more people away from the old stoves.

> > At the same time, EPA spokeswoman Alison Davis recently tried to whitewash the agency's position against wood stoves by claiming that the EPA is "not in the business of telling people

how to heat their homes." No, it is actually in the business of restricting the types of wood stoves manufacturers are allowed to produce and sell, which ultimately does tell people how to heat their homes by robbing them of their freedom

"Going underground is the opposite of hunkering down and keeping quiet about your faith," says Foley. "It's about training families, not institutions, to be the center of church life -- equipping them to be 'Living Bibles' in their neighborhoods, with the church

relying on them to take on for their sphere of influence all the functions of church life that churches usually reserve for pastors."

Foley created a structured discipleship training program that trains families to grow to fullness in Christ. Part of that is internalizing,

without external aids, what he calls the "bookshelf" of the faith: The Nicene Creed and one Bible passage and one classic hymn weekly, which he says is how most Christians around the world through history have learned and retained theology.

"People say,
'Oh, you're a

house church that memorizes Bible verses,' but that's not accurate," says Foley. "We work a lot with small groups in traditional churches as well. What distinguishes us is outcome-based structured discipleship training strategies. Jesus says hearing the word is only half the learning. Books

Doing the word is fully 50% of what Christianity is all about."

What does going underground look like for a traditional church? Foley says it's about investing 100% of the church functions in mem-

bers where they live, not clergy in church buildings, and revamping services "to have church wherever those in your sphere of influence congregate. Then, instead of having to attract people to some special location, you hear and do the word right where they have no choice but to see it."

Season ends, but Tebow inspired fans on and off the field

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. (BP) --Tim Tebow's riveting and tumultuous season ended Jan. 14, with the New England Patriots hammering the Denver Broncos 45-10 in an AFC divisional playoff game.

"A lot of ups and downs," Tebow said about his second NFL season after the loss in Foxborough, Mass. "Overall, it's been a very special opportunity for me, something I'm really thankful for. There's a lot of things we're proud of. Obviously, it's hard to see them all right now," Tebow was quoted as saying.

Still, Tebow's performance over the course of the season earned him the right to be the starting quarterback entering the 2012 season, Denver vice president of football operations John Elway said Monday (Jan. 16).

The popular quarterback, whose habit of kneeling in prayer on the football field started a nationwide trend of copycats engaged in "Tebowing," inspired millions of fans with his positive attitude, charitable work with the seriously ill and overt references to his faith in Jesus Christ. He also earned the derision and mockery of others who didn't share his religious beliefs.

Tebow's penchant for pulling out seemingly impossible wins also sparked a lively debate about the role God plays in a player's success.

"It may be that Tebow will succeed in spectacular fashion; it may be that he will have the worst game of his life," Owen

worst game of his life," Owen Strachan, professor of theology and church history at Boyce College, wrote in an article in The Atlantic before the game with the Patriots.

"Either way, the Bible assures us that God loves his chosen, God is orchestrating every detail of their lives, and God will lead them through success or failure to the end of all things."

Tebow's status with the Broncos was a touchy subject even from the start of the team's training camp. Several football analysts were pessimistic about his prospects as a successful NFL quarterback, and at one time speculation loomed that Tebow might fall to third-string behind Brady Quinn.

Things changed, however, when Denver went only 1-4 under then-quarterback Kyle Orton. The Broncos handed the starting job to Tebow who led the team to a 7-1 record over the

Though Tebow struggled late in the season and the Broncos lost their final three games, they squeaked into the playoffs when



In the Pitts vs Denver playoff game Tebow had 316 total passing yards and averaged 31.6 yards per pass and the final quarter-hour TV rating for the game was 31.6, which caused millions to remember then Google Tim's favorite verse – John 3:16.

Oakland lost its final game to San Diego, giving Denver the division title with an 8-8 record. In Denver's opening-round playoff game against Pittsburgh Jan. 8, Tebow had his best game in the NFL -- throwing for 316 yards, including an 80-yard touchdown pass on the first play in overtime to give the Broncos a shocking win.

But Tebow couldn't duplicate that success against the Patriots. New England quarterback Tom Brady threw six touchdown passes, and Tebow completed only nine of 26 passing attempts for 136 yards.

"I just wanted to show character, and anytime you get beat like that, you continue to fight," Tebow said after the game. "It doesn't change who you are, how you play, how you go out there. You should be the same at all times, and that's what I wanted to show."

Throughout the season, Tebow was the subject of mockery and

scorn by some -- such as Detroit Lions linebacker Stephen Tulloch, who kneeled in a mocking prayerful pose after sacking Tebow in an Oct. 30 game. Others, including Baltimore Ravens linebacker Terrell Suggs, were more vocal in their criticism. "We don't need

God on our sidelines," Suggs said in reference to Tebow.

Despite the criticism, by the end of the season Tebow was earning the fanfare of writers and fans alike. ESPN columnist Rick Reilly, in an article titled "I believe in Tim Tebow," reported on Tebow's actions toward those who have serious illnesses.

ons "Every week, Tebow picks out someone who is suffering, or who is dying, or who is injured," Reilly wrote. "He flies these people and their families to the Broncos game, rents them a car, puts them up in a nice hotel, buys them dinner (usually at a

Dave & Buster's), gets them and

their families pregame passes, visits with them just before kickoff (!), gets them 30-yard-line tickets down low, visits with them after the game (sometimes for an hour), has them walk him to his car, and sends them off with a basket of gifts."

Reilly said such actions, regardless of Tebow's performance on the field, are praiseworthy.

"I've given up giving up on him," Reilly wrote. "I'm a 100 percent believer. Not in his arm. Not in his skills. I believe in his heart, his there-will-definitely-be-a-pony-under-the-tree optimism, the way his love pours into people, right up to their eyeballs, until they believe they can master the hopeless comeback, too."

Tebow, who won the Heisman Trophy as a quarterback at the University of Florida, is a member of First Baptist Church in Jacksonville, Fla.

The "Fair Plan"?

"Hello, I'm from the government and I'm here to help you". When you hear these words, run!

Natural disaster is something beyond our ability to control. We may however prepare and insolate/"insure" ourselves against it. In doing so there is always cost associated and we all bare that cost in order to secure our financial well-being and that of our families. Having said this, we expect to pay a "reasonable" price/rate for that peace of mind and to be treated as equals under the laws and regulations. Discrimination based on perceived means or status should never figure into what one is charged for the same "insurance" or any product for that matter. Truth is I know this to be always easier said than done, especially in terms of the current political climate.

I recently had the pleasure of speaking with Paula Aschettino of "Citizens for Homeowners Insurance Reform", (CHIR) a not for profit organization of property owners fighting for fair, reasonable, non-excessive homeowners insurance rates without the loss of coverage and no shift of risk to the consumers. Paula and her group are calling to task the so called "Fair plan", which is essentially

a group of insurers born out of Massachusetts state Legislation in order to deflect individual insurance company liability in the event of loss. While not a government agency per-se, this group has its own "overseers" or Board of Directors, along with 6 citizen appointees who have little or no input with regard to policy. At the time of this writing I am researching the Board to determine who they are, respective to the original legislation, its authors and any other person who might be associated with what appears to me to be a quasi-political agency.

The meat of CHIR's argument

seems rooted in the "Fair Plan" and how it determines what rates shall apply and to whom, as well as what appear to be significant and unwarranted increases in the premiums charged primarily to home owners in proximity to the water. Aschettino also notes that some inland home owners of lessor means are also grouped in as "higher risk" and have seen their rates increase as well. Apparently, the increase(s) are based on what Aschettino feels is flawed data provided by ISO structural and weather related information from companies outside of the Bay State which are not using "Massachusetts accurate statistics" past and/or present. Moreover, these companies are in some cases even owned by the insurance companies affiliated with the "Fair Plan" themselves. Now there's a surprise... Models of hypothetical events calculated using data from around the coastal United States are used in assessing the risk for the Coastal Cape and Islands. This also applies to structural worthiness assessments, not necessarily exclusive to the area building codes and a host of other requirements in MA which meet and in some cases even exceed the national standards.

All of this is further complicated by the Massachusetts Division of Insurance and what Aschettino says is their unwillingness to step in and make adjustments. As is always the case in these situations, one has to question their motivations in terms of political influence within the "Fair Plan". 

truth about his cult a bigot."



Trusting God

Istumbled onto a "Trust Me" issue with God recently, the issue of creation — specifically, a six, 24-hour-day creation that God accomplished some 6,000 to 10,000 years ago. I introduced the subject on the daily radio show I host, anticipating we would discuss it for an hour. That hour turned into five days.

Where do you stand on the subject? Do you believe the literal Genesis account of a "young earth"? Per-



haps you more readily believe in the "gap" theory, which conjectures that between Genesis chapter one, verse one and two, there is a "gap" of billions of years.

Maybe you're more of a "long dayold earth" creationist. According to this theory, God created the world, but He did it through evolution, so each day in Genesis chapter one represents a billion years or so.

Friend, this is a "Trust Me" issue. The entire Bible crumbles if Genesis one through nine are not literally true. Let me explain. If God did not create the world in six 24-hour days, then:

- 1. God is a liar. If you believe that all Scripture is inspired by God (II Peter 1:21, II Timothy 3:16), then God lied when He said that "the evening and the morning were the first day."
- 2. Scripture is unreliable. Forty-five percent of the Old Testament quotes Genesis and 25 percent of the New Testament quotes Genesis. If Genesis is not reliable, neither is the rest of the Bible.
- 3. Jesus is a liar. In Matt.19:4, Jesus says, "Haven't you read the Scriptures? They record that from the beginning, 'God made them male and female.'" Jesus was quoting Genesis 1:27. Was Jesus perpetuating a lie? Did He not know that we evolved? Why would Jesus say "in the beginning" if He didn't mean "in the beginning"?
- 4. God is mean. Romans 5:12 says, "When Adam sinned, sin entered the entire human race. Adam's sin brought death, so death spread to everyone, for everyone sinned." The Bible obviously teaches that man is the cause of sin and is therefore the cause of death. If we evolved, then God is responsible for all of the death that happened prior to Adam. That makes Him a very mean God.
- 5. Jesus' atoning work for you is either disputable or a complete joke. Romans 5:15 says, "For this one man, Adam, brought death to many through his sin. But this other man, Jesus Christ, brought The Good Pews TODAY

forgiveness to many through God's bountiful gift." Uh oh. If Adam wasn't the first person on earth and the one responsible for sin and death, is Jesus sacrifice real? Was it necessary? Was it complete?

If you do not believe in the literal Genesis account of creation, I suggest that you have one of five problems:

- 1. You are a new believer and have been taught a lie.
- 2. You are not reading your Bible. There is nothing confusing about Exodus 20:11: "... in six days the Lord made the Heavens, the

earth, the sea, and everything in them: then he rested on the seventh day."

3. You are picking and choosing what parts of Scripture you think are true and tossing out verses that either challenge you or you don't like. Sorry Charlie, you can't do that. Why on earth would you think YOU can pick and choose

what YOU think is right and wrong about the Bible? If you interpret the Bible figuratively, then you might as well not believe in Jesus, because maybe He was just a fairy tale, too.

4. Your faith is weak. You acknowledge God, but you aren't willing to completely trust Him. You are intimidated by bad science and it has caused you not to surrender completely.

5. Your faith is non-existent. Consider Romans 1:20, "From the time the world was created, people have seen the earth and sky and all that God made. They can clearly see his invisible qualities — His eternal power and divine nature. So they have no excuse whatsoever." You know God created the world, but you are being willingly ignorant. God says you are being obstinate, and worse than that, you may have no faith. "Yes, they knew God, but they wouldn't worship Him as God or even give Him thanks. And they began to think up foolish ideas of what God was like. The result was that their minds became dark and confused. Claiming to be wise, they became utter fools instead." (Rom.1:21-22)

This is not a child's game. This game has eternal consequences. God is standing behind you right now and asking, "Do you trust Me?"

We all need someone to confide in, someone to trust with our innermost hopes and fears. More importantly we all need to know that we are forgiven for our inadequacies, our sin. Even if you think you've never done anything wrong, think again, haven't you done something wrong by not accepting the love which your friend has offered to you since the day that you were born? Start by asking Him to forgive you for ignoring that love which he has given you throughout your life. Say a simple prayer like this:

Jesus, please forgive me for my sin. I know I haven't done everything that I should with my life and I've often ignored your attempts to love me, to be a part of it. I know that you died for me and that you have a plan for my life. Please

-- It's all over the news now, the disparity between the "99 per cent" and the "One per cent" -- or, rather, the resentment and envy that the majority is supposed to harbor against the more wealthy. It is at the core of the "Occupy" crowds' chants and signs.

Theodore Roosevelt correctly

observed that the sin of envy is no less a sin than that of greed. And years ago, a friend from France once gave me the best definition of Socialism (therefore, its most potent pushback). Francois Mitterand had been elected president in his country; the Socialists were coming to power; and among their proposals, in the name of equality, was the abolition of First-Class seats on public transportation.

"Why is it that the Socialists never want to abolish anything that is second-class?" my friend asked.

That riposte has come to mind when hearing so often lately of the Ninety-Nine versus the One per cents. "Versus" is the operative word; a campaign to raise the civic temperature. But something else has come to mind -- that Jesus had a different take on the numbers of 99 and one. Nothing to do with current politics except as those numbers provide a shout-out to our souls.

Let us remember Christ's parable

of the Lost Sheep. It is found in Luke 15:4-7. The gentle shepherd had a flock of 100, but one had gone astray, and he set out to search, high and low, far and wide, for that wayward sheep. The sheep was found, rescued, and restored to the shepherd's flock.

Many of us have the natural reaction to think that the sensible thing would have been to play safe with the ninety-nine. A similar impulse, in the other parable of the Prodigal Son, is to observe that the other son was slighted after all of his work

teach me your ways and help me to live my life for you, free from the fears of this world and the next. I want to be ready for eternity with you. Amen

Our problem as humans is that we tend to see ourselves as members of the flock of ninety-nine. "What is one sheep against so many?" We get proud of our accomplishments, jealous of others receiving favor. Our bigger problem is that God sees us as that Lost Sheep, and the son who departed and sinned -- not

as we see ourselves.

"The Ninety and Nine" was written as a children's poem by Elizabeth Clephane in 1868. The great hymnwriter Ira D Sankey read it when on a Dwight L Moody crusade in Scotland three decades later; he tucked it into his vest pocket. That evening Moody preached on

"The Good Shepherd," and asked Sankey, his worship leader, to sing a hymn. Sankey remembered that poem in his pocket, took it out, and sang this song impromptu, forming the music as he went. It is now a standard of the church.

Jesus not only seeks us out; He persists. For us to be as THAT "one percenter" we should be grateful and can take assurance. Occupy God's flock.

KINGS AND QUEENS MINISTRY TIP

By Rev. Doug Forbes

The Bible is filled with stories about kings and queens, and these stories will come to life when your students make their own crowns.

To make crowns you need: Bibles and Bible concordances, newspaper, Bible Story Coloring Pages from your favorite Christian bookstore, gold spray paint, various shapes of colored confetti such as stars and hearts, glitter, plastic sandwich bags, glue sticks, a few Bible verse stickers for each student and crowns from Burger King. Or, you can make your own crown outline and have the children cut out their own crowns from poster board. (To get Burger King crowns simply ask the store manager. Burger King is well known for it's generosity to community groups.)

Before class place the crowns on newspaper and spray paint the white side with gold. Fill plastic bags with colored confetti and a few Bible verse stickers for each child. Decide which Bible story about a king or queen that you will teach that day, and reproduce the appropriate coloring page from your Bible Story Coloring Pages book.

Break your students into teams of two, and instruct them to use their Bibles and concordances to find passages that refer to kings and queens. Allow time for each team to share their findings, and then conduct a short Bible study on your favorite king or queen. For example: King David and Queen Esther were brave, King Solomon was wise, or King Hezekiah obeyed God.

Distribute a crown, glue sticks, and a plastic bag filled with colored confetti, glitter and stickers to each student. Instruct the young people to decorate the gold side of the crown to their liking in a creative manner. When everyone is finished, ask them to put on their crowns and take a group picture.

Pass out the Bible story coloring page you have chosen, read it with the class and allow the children to color it if time allows. If not, use the coloring sheet as a take home paper. Either way, encourage your students to re-read the Bible story with their parents or guardians at home.

Most American advertising is propaganda. Propaganda is pervasive in all retail pricing.

Banks use propaganda to make their loans seem easy to repay. Sadly even the Church of Jesus Christ is saturated with propaganda. Pastors woo potential church members with compliments and kindness, they preach sermons that emphasize love and fellowship, they promise healing and offer counseling...all this in spite of the fact that the God of the Bible holds His blessing hostage to obedience and promises punishment for those who dissent. Righteous obedience is as scarce in those who claim to follow Him as it is in those who reject Him.

Propaganda teaches Americans that vows and obedience to the law are easily broken; it teaches us that marriage commitments are as readily evaded as Constitutional law; that fidelity in marriage is trivial; that casual sexual intercourse is routine; and that lesbianism and homosexuality are normal preferences. We are subtly persuaded by media propaganda that the government is the sole solution to social problems and that passing laws will bring peace and order.

Christian Church leaders, eager to pacify their inflated egos, quickly bought the scourge of Dispensationalism. It is a blasphemous tool that dissolves the obligation of obedience and creates a flaccid Christianity. Dispensationalism is Christian propaganda. In spite of the fact that there were more Christians slaughtered by Jewish cadre during the Russian Revolution than Jews killed by Der Fuhrer, powerful Zionist Jews have been successful in developing an emotion driven sympathy by convincing the American public that Hitler's evil attempt to annihilate their race

was the only major genocide in history. Failure to present the public with complete coverage of both current and historic news is a malignant form of propaganda.

We go to sleep and wake with media propaganda, our day is consumed by conformance to work place propaganda and we live with the detrimental propaganda of smaller portions, thinner papers, impersonal contacts, and dilatory remedies.

Government propaganda has been so successful that hundreds of thousands of elected officials and government employees have adamantly accepted lies as truth; they passionately believe that our nation is under attack and freedoms must be forsaken. Unfortunately, many of the brain washed minions are obedient citizens not blest with acute discernment, men and women who believe the lies of an evil regime and support it to their own detriment, over and over again.

Jesus said "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life" and "The Truth shall make you free". Truth brought Him to the Cross. Truth is scarce and dangerous, seldom accepted and regularly crushed.


