Where the federal government was contracted (via the

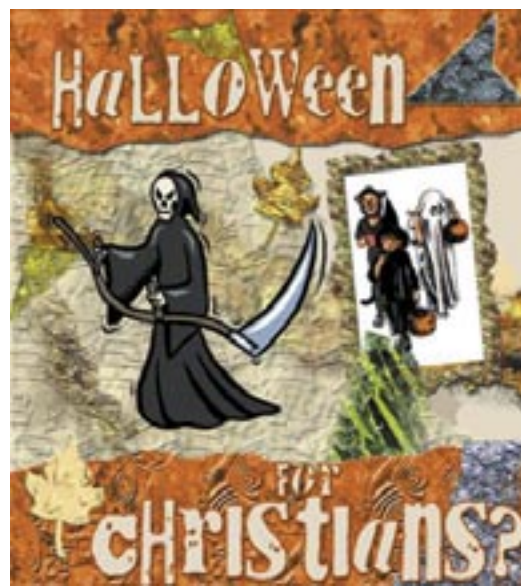

## Halloween or Reformation Day?

Let me ask you a question. What do you think of when you hear the date October 31<sup>st</sup>? Most people will answer Halloween! But, that is NOT what is important about October 31! Halloween has its roots in paganism. Halloween is a religious celebration day, but most certainly it is not a Christian day!



Ralph Linton in his book *Halloween Through the Centuries*, says “The American celebration (of Halloween) rests upon Scottish and Irish folk customs which can be traced in a direct line from pre-Christian times. The earliest celebrations were held by the DRUIDS in honor of Shamhain, lord of

death, whose festival fell on November 1st.” Another source goes on to expand this by saying, “The Celts considered November 1st as being the day of death

because the leaves were falling, it was getting darker sooner and temperatures were dropping. They believed their sun god, was losing strength because Samhain, lord of death, was overpowering him. Further, they believed that on October 31st Samhain assembled the

spirits of all who had died during the previous year. They had been confined to inhabit animals’ bodies for the past year as punishment for their evil deeds.

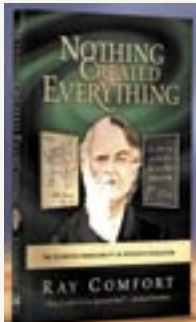

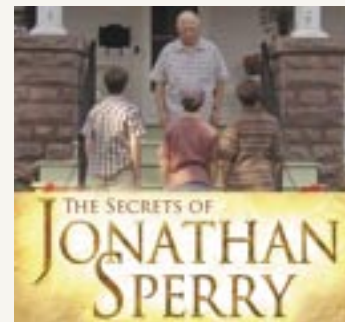

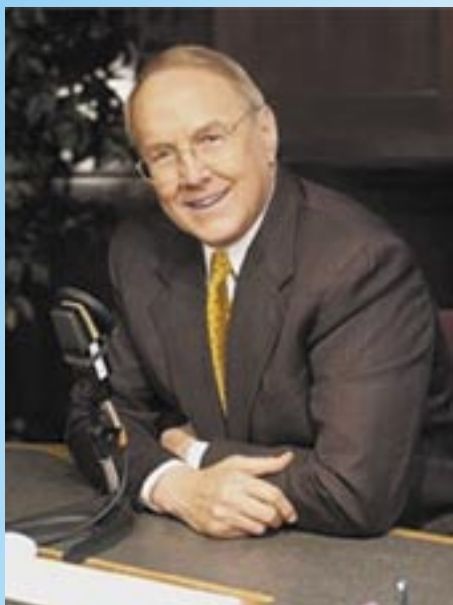

On the eve of the feast of Samhain, October 31st, they were allowed to return to their former homes to visit the living. Supposedly to protect these people, Druid priests led the people in diabolical worship ceremonies in which horses, cats, black sheep, oxen, human beings and other offerings were rounded up, stuffed into wicker cages and burned to death. This was done to appease Samhain and keep the spirits from harming them."

The late George Douglas adds some interesting information when he says "Many of Halloween's customs are derived from the ancient Baal Festivals. Other customs originate from the taking of omens from the struggles of victims in the fires of druidic sacrifices." (*The American Book of Days*, by George William Douglas revised by Helen Douglas Compton).

Probably the best documentation as to whether Halloween is a pagan religious celebration day comes from pagan testimony. When asked "Does anyone today celebrate Samhain (Halloween) as a religious Holiday?" a major witches' organization responded, "Yes, many followers of various pagan religions, such as Druids and Wiccans (witches), observe this day as a religious festival. They view it as a memorial day for their dead friends.... It is still a night to practice various forms of divination concerning future events. (from *Cult Watch Response*, October 1988, Vol. 1, No. 1).

I was in Salem Massachusetts in the early 1990's. I had been invited there to do some radio programs on exposing the occult nature of Halloween. While I was there a witch from Salem had an article in the *Sunday People* magazine acknowledging that Halloween is a witchcraft holiday. She said, "Salem is a mecca, especially around Samhain. **It's our holiday**, our New Year's and a lot of witches come here from all over the world."

**Wearing grotesque costumes** has its origin in pagan worship. You will recall that their superstition taught evil spirits roamed on Halloween. They believed that the only way these people could escape being attacked was by assuming disguises and looking like the evil spirits themselves."

Now, just by chance if you had forgotten to dress up or could not fool the evil spirits by dressing in animal skins or other disguises, there was a way to exorcise them. People were to set out a TREAT

of food and fruit, and provide the wandering spirit with shelter for the night. If the demon spirit was satisfied with your TREAT, it was believed that he would not TRICK you by casting an evil spell on you thereby causing havoc. This is the origin of *Trick or Treat*.

I discovered the pagan origins of Halloween in 1980 and have not celebrated Halloween since then. Why? Because the Bible says, "And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them." **Ephesians 5:11**. Further, it says, "Whether

therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God." **1 Corinthians 10:31**.

In reality, Halloween, a day with pagan roots, has been used to cover-up perhaps the most important day of Western civilization, which also happened on October 31st! This day was an emancipation day, a day when the lies and superstitions of the Roman Catholic Church were boldly uncovered. What I am talking about is the event that took place on October 31st 486 years ago. On that day in 1517, Martin Luther posted his *Ninety-Five Theses* on the door of the Castle Church in Wittenberg, Germany.

His beginning paragraph said...

"Out of love for the truth and from desire to elucidate it, the Reverend Father Martin Luther, Master of Arts and Sacred Theology, and ordinary lecturer therein at Wittenberg, intends to defend the following statements and to dispute on them in that place. Therefore he asks that those who cannot be present and dispute with him orally shall do so in their absence by letter. In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, Amen."

Two examples of his 95 Theses are: 1. They preach mere human follies who maintain that, as soon as the coin rattles in the strong box, the soul flies out of purgatory. 2. The indulgence of the Pope cannot take away the smallest daily sin, as far as regards the guilt, or the offence.

So what were indulgences? The Catholic Church taught that you could buy the forgiveness of sin from the church or that you could buy the release from Purgatory for someone. In that era, when the Bible was kept from the people, the Catholic Church deceived many people into believing the lies that they taught, such as the existence of Purgatory and the effectiveness of indulgences, and swindled them out of their hard earned money. I recently walked through the massive and beautiful edifice of St. Peters in Rome and could not help but think of the fact that it was built by the sale of indulgences. Historians mark the posting of Luther's *Ninety-Five Theses* October 31st, 1517 as the beginning of the Reformation.

So, **what was the Reformation?** In short, the Reformation was the great rediscovery of the Gospel, the good news of Salvation by grace through faith. The established church had kept the common people ignorant of the truths of God's Word and manipulated them with contrived superstitions for a thousand years during the period called *the Dark Ages*.

What motivated Luther to post 95 Theses? He wanted people to know the truth of salvation by grace through faith in Christ. He remembered his struggle to free himself from his own sinfulness. Let me give you a brief synopsis of his struggle.

When he was in college, he and a friend were walking and a storm came up. Lightning struck and killed his friend Alexis. Luther cried out in prayer to Saint Anne to save him, promising to become a monk. He lived and so entered the Augustinian Monastery. While rummaging around the library he came across a Latin Bible and the works of John Huss which he read intently. He read of salvation by grace through faith. But this was in conflict with the teachings of the



Church! He redoubled his efforts to earn his salvation by torturing himself for his sins by fasting, praying, and whipping himself. But this was all fruitless. He came into contact with Dr. Johann Von Staupitz who told him of the sin-remitting grace of God and redemption that only comes through the Blood of Christ. They read the Latin Bible together and thought deeply on the free grace of God.

Luther made one last attempt to atone for his own sins. He went to Rome in 1510 and while climbing the 28 stairs of Pilate's Staircase on his knees to do penance and gain some indulgence he clearly heard a voice like thunder say - "**The just shall live by faith.**" (see Romans 1:17; Galatians 3:11). This changed the direction of his life. He preached against indulgences. He wrote a book called *Concerning Christian Liberty*, which taught the priesthood of every believer (see 1 Peter 2:5,9; Revelation 1:5-6). He taught that every Christian had the right and duty to approach God for himself without the aid of human priests. This put him at odds with the Catholic Church! Leo X issued a decree calling for Luther's works to be burned and for him to appear in Rome and recant or be burnt. His response was to burn the decree. He was called to Worms to be tried for heresy. On April 17th, 1521 he appears before the

ecclesiastical court and Dr. Eck shows him his books and asks if he recants. Luther says -

"I cannot submit my faith either to the Pope or to the Councils because it is clear as day they have frequently erred and contradicted each other. Unless therefore, I am convinced by the testimony of Scripture...I can and will not retract. Here I stand...I can do no other. So help me God, Amen!"

Luther would have been convicted and burned as an heretic had it

not been for a poster that appeared on the walls of the chamber stating that there were 400 knights and 800 men-at-arms ready to take vengeance if Luther is harmed. The Diet (council) rules that he may hold his opinions, but that he must do it quietly.

As he leaves to make his way back home, he is kidnapped by friends

and taken to Wartburg Castle for safety. He is disguised as a knight and called Junker (knight) Georg. There at the Wartburg he translates the 2nd edition of Erasmus' Greek New Testament into German in 11 weeks. It is issued September 1522 and spreads like wildfire across Germany. The light of God's Word shattered the darkness of the Dark Ages and the iron grip Rome hand on Western Europe. There is an old saying that goes "Erasmus laid the egg and Luther hatched it. William

Tyndale hatched the English Egg. He translated the 3rd edition of Erasmus' New Testament into English in 1526, thus bringing to an end the ignorance and superstitions of the Dark Ages and the Roman Catholic Church's iron grip on the minds of the people.

The Bible says "The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple." **Psalms 119:130**

While we certainly do not hold to Luther's beliefs on sprinkling babies, communion and various other things, I can say, he was used of God to reintroduce Salvation by grace through faith in Christ alone and translate and print the Bible, from a good text, into the language of the people. Tyndale met with Luther when he was a fugitive and likely received his counsel in preparing his English version of the New Testament. Tyndale was martyred in October 1536 at Vilvoorde after he had lead his jailer and family to the Lord.

I must say I find it strange that most American Christians celebrate Halloween, a holiday with pagan roots on October 31st rather than Reformation Day, a day which forever changed papal Rome's domination of religion in the Western world. October 31st was the Declaration of Independence from Roman dogma, tradition and superstition and a return to the biblical Gospel. I would urge you to **REJECT HALLOWEEN, THE GREAT COVER-UP.**

need God, either.

It is no hyperbole to say that the U.S. federal government has been on a "Ban God" bandwagon for the past 50 years. Whether it kicks prayer and Bible reading out of school, bars military chaplains from praying in Jesus' name, burns Bibles in Iraq, removes state supreme court chief justices from their positions for posting the Ten Commandments, or threatens high school principals with jail for asking the blessing, the federal government has invoked the judgment of Heaven upon our country as surely as did Old Testament Israel.

Although the comfortable, sports-crazed, TV addicts probably aren't paying attention, this country is on the verge of an implosion like you cannot believe. For anyone who cares to notice, the signs are everywhere.

First of all, Israel and Iran are on the verge of war. And right now, I'm not concentrating on the "why" or "who's right or wrong" of the equation. I'm simply telling you, war between Israel and Iran could break out at any time. And when it does, the chances that it will not become nuclear and not become global are miniscule. Yes, I am saying it: the prospects for nuclear war have never been greater. The CBS-canceled TV show, JERICHO, could become a reality in these United States in the very near future. (I strongly urge readers to purchase both seasons of JERICHO and watch them, because this could be our future.)

Secondly, America is on the verge of total financial collapse. By the

end of this year, America's budget deficit will stand at around \$2 trillion. The debt gap is many trillions more than that. But the nail in the coffin for America's fiscal health will be the decision by China to dump the U.S. dollar. Ladies and gentlemen, this will be the death knell for our financial stability (and a painful lesson in sowing and reaping).

It is estimated that China owns around one-third of all U.S. debt. If and when China dumps the U.S. dollar, there would be nothing left to stabilize it, and Weimar Republic/Zimbabwe-style inflation will ensue. America will be thrust into financial chaos. (If one doubts

is currently purchasing and stockpiling gold at an unprecedented level. This is why gold has suddenly surged to over \$1,000 per ounce and why it will continue to rise.)

Third, the paranoia regarding the Swine Flu being demonstrated by both government and media spokesmen begs a giant push for some type of "government solu-

bypass surgery, mitral valve regurgitation, and his Cardiologist was pressing for another surgery. The doctor seemed irritated by all of the questions he had and he abruptly told Pastor Dunlap "You had heart surgery at age 56; most people who have heart surgery do not live too long. Disgusted by the negative forecast, he refused to agree to another surgery so he went to see Dr. Sinatra for a second opinion.

"You don't have to die if you suddenly learn that you have heart disease; you can live a healthy life and you can live within your comfort zone," Dr Sinatra told him. Pastor Dunlap said, "This other guy (doctor) was pushing me to go right through another surgery, he neglected to tell him that most people my age have problems with their heart. They often have some type of degenerative disease"

Dr Sinatra promotes four specific pillars of cardiac health: (1) an anti-inflammatory diet rich in fresh fruit and vegetables, whole grains, fish, nuts and healthy oils, similar to the Mediterranean diet, (2) nutritional supplementation that includes a high-potency multi-nutrient, fish oil, magnesium, vitamin C and coenzyme Q10, (3) regular exercise and (4) stress reduction. He is critical of refined sugar, which he has called, "public enemy number one when it comes to heart disease, not cholesterol."

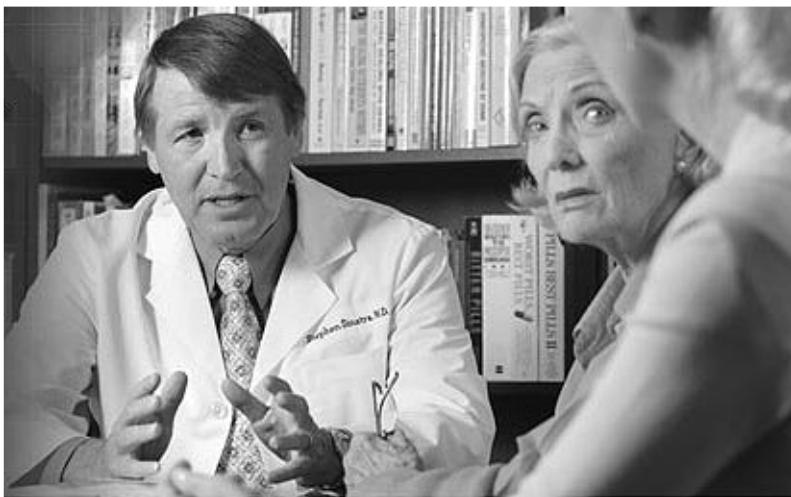
Prior to going to Dr, Sinatra, Ellie said, he could hardly make it up a flight of stairs. Dr Sinatra started him on his "reversing heart disease plan" and Pastor Dunlap said that "In just two weeks I recaptured my quality of life," and "I was able to carry on an almost unbelievable hectic schedule as a full-time minister."

The results are quite evident; Pastor Dunlap is a dynamic, riveting preacher who became Senior Pastor at Second Baptist Church in 1996. He is energetic and vibrant and he appears to be at least ten years younger than he is. Ellie also looks younger than her years. They are both well liked and respected by the church body. Pastor Dunlap's evangelistic heart is evident in what he preaches, and in conver-

sation. Regardless of the topic of his sermons, they eventually point to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and the *only* way to spend eternity with God in Heaven.

Pastor Dunlap told me,"I know that people are lost and that they need Jesus Christ. He *is* the answer. He gives us the cure and we need to accept Him, for the abundance of real life. In the meantime, he said, "What happened to me (after being treated by Dr. Sinatra) can happen to anybody, and I would love to see it happen to them; to have the same energy that has been given to me." Dr. Sinatra is no longer seeing new patients due to his busy schedule so this opportunity to benefit from him should not be passed up!

According to his biography, Dr. Sinatra realized his calling to medicine from an early age. As a boy growing up in New York, he

was greatly affected by his mother's painful battle with diabetes, glaucoma, and eventual blindness. Though helpless in alleviating her suffering, he felt that as a doctor, he might be able to help others. He credits her illness with causing him to look deeper into himself, and helping him become the kind of doctor who truly cares about his patients.

Dr. Sinatra freely admits that early in his career, he took pride in how busy he was admitting patients to the hospital. But while caring for those people, he began taking note of something more important than their symptoms. The frequency with which he saw them—often to "fix" the same old problems—was humbling. Slowly he realized that even though he was a highly trained cardiologist with the ability to save people who were a heartbeat from death, he didn't have a clue about how to actually keep them healthy.

That revelation led Dr. Sinatra to begin studying heart disease from nontraditional perspectives. Because so many of his patients had high-achieving Type

A personalities, for example, he took courses in bioenergetics analysis (a field that examines the relationship between the mind and the physical body). He also immersed himself in nutrition, learning how vitamins and minerals influence cardiovascular health.

At first, Dr. Sinatra recommended supplements and lifestyle improvements sparingly. But as patients responded with speedier recoveries and improved health, he quickly expanded his arsenal of therapies. He followed a strict process for doing so, first thoroughly researching the nutrients or activities, then trying them himself, and ultimately recommending them to others. (Even after 35 years of practice, Dr. Sinatra will not promote a nutritional supplement that he hasn't tried. He also regularly takes the supplements that he encourages others to make part of their daily routine.)

Today Dr. Sinatra describes himself as an integrative cardiologist. That is, he prefers to treat heart disease by using the best of both conventional and alternative medicine. Sometimes that means relying on

pharmaceutical drugs and high-tech equipment—but it's just as likely to include mind-body activities that reduce stress and nutritional therapies that enhance cell metabolism. Dr. Sinatra strongly believes that the more efficient your body's cells are at creating and burning energy, the better your overall health will be. This is especially true of the heart, which uses more energy than any other organ in the body.

Pastor Dunlap was born in Portsmouth, NH in 1941. He described himself as being a "good kid," more interested in basketball and football rather than getting into trouble with some of his peers. Although his mother and sister were devout Christians, he did not feel any particular leaning towards the Lord. Then, a deacon named Claude Williams invited him to play basketball with the Christian Brigade Service club. Enticed by the love of basketball, Pastor Dunlap agreed and he later went along with the group to a Billy Graham Crusade in Boston, MA. The date was January 16, 1957 when he responded to the invitation to accept Jesus Christ

as Lord and Savior.

Prior to coming to Second Baptist Church, Pastor Dunlap served the Lord as an evangelist, spreading the Word of Jesus Christ to churches throughout the United States and other parts of the world. It is estimated that he has traveled about two million miles preaching the message of hope in the Lord. He was widely known for his ability to minister to "hurting churches;" those that are struggling with discontent about a myriad of issues.

His teaching and preaching the precious Words of God have resulted in thousands deciding to dedicate their lives to Christ. He has been a speaker at conferences and even assisted in a few of the Billy Graham crusades. Pastor Dunlap has written and published thirteen books; one that I saw is an expository of the book of Revelations. He has created SermonSeeker.com in which he presents written and audio taped sermons to pastors throughout the world and the US. In addition this man with seemingly unbounded energy is still able to effectively shepherd a busy church!

While Ellie was sitting in Dr. Sinatra's waiting room one day, an elderly man came in. He told her that the previous week he had

attended a seminar about heart disease that was run by several doctors. He said that the doctors were very gloomy, pointing to surgery as the only solution. He said that he had left the seminar thinking "My days are numbered." He called Dr. Sinatra and, the man said, "Boy, What a change! You come walking out of his office filled with hope that you can get over this!"

Dr. Sinatra believes that doctors do not heal anyone, nature does. He works with his patients; he listens to his patients and he learns from his patients. He does believe in the divine, beyond what a doctor does. He believes that "the doctor nurses," but ultimately it is God who heals. In his writing, Dr. Sinatra sometimes refers to his unique brand of cardiology as preventive or metabolic. But no matter what it's called, it can always be summed up in a single word—*effective*.

## Study Reveals Impact of Social Media on Evangelical Christian College Students

(EP News)--When they're not sending text messages or tweets, today's Christian college students are spending time on Facebook. A lot of it. One in every three says he's spending 1-2 hours a day on the site. Twelve percent report using it 2-4 hours each day and 2.8 percent report usage at 4-7 hours a day. That's in addition to other forms of social media and electronic usage such as video games, blogs, e-mail and Internet browsing. The Gordon College study, "Pulling Off the Mask: The Impact of Social Networking Activities on Evangelical Christian College Students . . . A Self-Reported Study" explores the specific trends, behaviors and attitudes Christian students perceive of themselves regarding social media usage. Over half (54 percent) reported that they were "neglecting important areas of their life" due to spending too much time on these sites. And when asked if one were to define addiction as "any behavior you cannot stop, regardless of the consequences," 12.7 percent affirmed that they believe they are addicted to some form of electronic activity.

## Family Group Says Obamacare Will Put Planned Parenthood In Public Schools

(EP News)--As America processes the president's health care reform speech, the American Family Association is drawing attention to a little-noticed provision in H.R. 3200, the House version of ObamaCare, which will put Planned Parenthood clinics inside America's public schools. Under the provisions of section with the innocuous-sounding title, "School-Based Health Clinics" (pp. 993-1001 of the bill), a "non-profit health agency" such as Planned Parenthood will be authorized to serve as a "sponsoring facility" for school-based health clinics that will operate during school hours. Although the bulk of the health care bill is scheduled to go into effect in 2013, this particular provision is slated to go into effect next summer, in time for clinics to appear in public schools by next fall.

## N.H. Court Orders Home-Schooled Girl into Public School

(EP News)--The Alliance Defense Fund (ADF) has asked a New Hampshire court to reconsider its decision to order a 10-year-old home-schooled girl into public school. "Parents have a fundamental right to make educational choices for their children," said ADF-allied attorney John

Anthony Simmons. "In this case, the court is illegitimately altering a method of education that the court itself admits is working." Mike Donnelly, staff attorney at the Home School Legal Defense Association, agreed this is "not the place for the courts to be inserting themselves."

## Homeschoolers Beat National Average on ACT

(EP News)--On a scale of 1-36, homeschoolers scored an average of 22.5 on the ACT, one of the nation's leading college entrance exams. The national average for the all students taking the test was 21.1. "This is a remarkable achievement and shows that homeschool parents are successfully preparing their children for college," said Michael Smith, president of HSLDA. A total of 1.48 million students took the ACT in 2009 which included 11,535 homeschoolers or just under 1 percent of the total. It has always been the position of homeschool advocates that the one-on-one instruction provided by dedicated parents is a more effective way to educate children. It's also much cheaper. The average public school spends \$10,000 per child per year whereas the average homeschooler spends \$500 per child per year. Homeschooling is also growing rapidly. The National Center for Education Statistics, part of the Federal Department of Education, estimates that homeschooling is growing at around 7 percent per year.

## Early symbol depicting Judaism found in Galilee

**Galilee, Israel (ANS)** -- Israeli archaeologists have uncovered one of the earliest depictions of a menorah, the seven-branched candelabra that has come to symbolize Judaism, the Israel Antiquities Authority said last week.

The menorah was engraved in stone around 2,000 years ago and found in a synagogue recently discovered by the Kinneret. Pottery, coins and tools found at the site indicate the synagogue dates to the period of the second Jewish temple in Jerusalem, where the actual menorah was kept, said archaeologist Dina Avshalom-Gorni of the Israel Antiquities Authority, according to The Associated Press (AP), cited in The Jerusalem Post newspaper.

The artist might have seen the menorah during a pilgrimage and then recreated it in the synagogue, she suggested. A small number of depictions of the menorah have surfaced from the same period,

she said, but this one was unique because it was inside a synagogue and far from Jerusalem, illustrating the link between Jews around Jerusalem and in the Galilee to the north.

The AP report says the menorah, depicted atop a pedestal with a triangular base, is carved on a stone which was placed in the synagogue's central hall. The temple in Jerusalem was destroyed by Roman legions in 70 CE. The

Arch of Titus in Rome, erected to mark the Roman victory, depicts troops carrying the menorah from Jerusalem to symbolize the defeat of the Jews. The menorah became a Jewish symbol and is featured today on Israel's official emblem.

Most other depictions of the menorah were made only after the temple's destruction, and if this finding is indeed earlier it could be closer to the original, said Aren Maeir, an archaeology professor at Bar-Ilan University in Israel, the AP report stated.

"If you have a depiction of the menorah from the time of the temple, chances are it is more accurate and portrays the actual object than portrayals from after the destruction of the temple, when it was not existent," he said.

The ancient prayer house was discovered in the town of Migdal, usually identified as the birthplace of the New Testament's Mary Magdalene, whose name is thought to be based on the town's.

### Pastor attacked in Andhra Pradesh State, India

**Hyderabad, India (ANS)** -- A pastor was attacked during a worship service at Warangal in Andhra Pradesh state, India, on Sunday, September 13, 2009.

According to news reported on the website -- www.christiancouncil.in -- the attack took place during a worship service at a house church called Opier Ministries Evangelical Church.

The website reported that Pastor Pilly Kumar was leading the worship service and at around 1:00PM, a group of ten Hindu radicals barged into the worship service and attacked Pastor Pilly.

According to the news source, there were around 25 believers present for the service at the house church. It was reported that it happened that after the Hindu radicals disrupted the worship service they caught hold of the pastor and man-handled him.

It was reported that that as the Hindu radicals tried to beat the pastor up, the believers present tried to rescue him and then drove the attackers away. The website said that the attackers destroyed the Church name board in front of the church.

The website said that at around 4:00 PM, the pastor, along with the church members, went to the local police station to file a complaint against the attackers who also arrived at the police station at the same time.

The police officer then told off both the groups, the attackers for taking law into their hands and the pastor for using the loud speaker and causing inconvenience to the people living around.

The website said that the pastor, however, insisted on filing a complaint against the culprits, but the police officer refused to accept it. The All India Christian Council (aicc) is now assisting the pastor in filing the case.

### Fasting and Praying for His Persecutors

**Assam, India (ANS)** -- Doru Nathi lay beaten and bleeding, left for dead on the side of a desolate road in Assam, India. The men who attacked him were furious with him about something he'd done earlier in the day; the severe beating was their revenge. What upset the attackers was that Doru and his pastor, Gospel for Asia-supported missionary Tarun Akansha, had shared the love of Christ with the people of their village.

Doru and Tarun had decided to spend a day at the village, distributing tracts and other Christian literature. The people of the village gladly accepted the materials. But soon a few people got angry after they read the tracts. They tore the literature up, sought out Tarun and Doru and hurled insults at them. The missionaries returned to their homes greatly discouraged.

That evening, some of the anti-Christian extremists came to Doru's home and kidnapped him. They dragged him back to their village and brutally beat him. With blood pouring out of his nose and mouth, they dumped him on the side of the road to die.

This is how his family found him. They took him home but were unable to obtain medical treatment for his injuries. They did not have adequate transportation from their remote village to get him to the hospital, nor did they have the money to pay for any treatment.

When word reached Tarun, he rushed to Doru's house. Tarun was distraught at the turn of events. Doru is an elder in the church where Tarun serves as pastor, and the two men are close. Tarun joined Doru's family in praying fervently for Doru's recovery. The Lord heard their prayers, and about midnight Doru regained consciousness and began talking again!

### Mob of 400 Launches Violent Attack on Fushan House Church

**SHANXI PROVINCE, CHINA (ANS)** -- ChinaAid (www.chinaaid.org) says that more than 400 'deviants' in police suits and red armbands broke into the Good News Cloth Shoes Factory, on the site of Fushan Church's new building in Linfin City, Shanxi province, at 3:00 a.m. on the morning of Sunday, September 13, 2009.

According to the ChinaAid report, two shovel loaders tore at the building foundations, while the mob, with bricks and other blunt instruments in hand, beat Fushan church members who were sleeping at the church construction site. Within the hour, more than ten church members lay bleeding heavily; some were severely injured and sent to the emergency room.

As Doru continued to heal, many in his village advised him to file charges with the local police against the men who attacked him. But Doru thought back to what he had learned while attending Tarun's church. He decided that he didn't want revenge, even if he was legally entitled to see his attackers brought to justice. He really just wants them to know that Jesus loves them. So rather than press charges, he has decided to fast and pray for his attackers.

He wants them to come to know Jesus, just like he did.

Doru asks for prayer that his body will completely heal and that his attackers will choose to follow Christ.

Prayer was also requested for Tarun, that the Lord will encourage him and use him continuously to share the love of Christ with the people in his village. Also pray for his protection.

ChinaAid says the local emergency room was instructed to withhold treatment and prohibit blood transfusions for the injured church members. The power, water and telephone signals to the factory were cut off.

In its report, ChinaAid stated: "Local government officials and police were identified among the wild crowd of attackers. The vandals smashed the windows, doors, kitchen utensils, refrigerators and motorcycles. Leaving destruction in their wake, they looted the television and other appliances, and stole church members' money, cell phones, clothes, books, and even the factory's busi-

ness license.

"After the demolition and looting, officials deliberately disposed of the evidence, and cleaned up some of the mess to hide their involvement. At noon on September 13th, thousands of church members gathered at the site in grief. They asked factory coworkers and community members to visit and pray for them."

ChinaAid President Bob Fu denounced the injustice. "We are totally shocked to hear of this

bloody crackdown against innocent Christian believers by the Fushan county officials," said Mr. Fu. "We urge the Chinese government to hold those abusive officials accountable and take concrete actions to guarantee the Fushan citizens' religious freedom."

ChinaAid calls on the international community "to voice their protests against the brutal treatment of Christians to the Chinese government, and to pray for justice and healing for the victims of the attack.

"We further pray for the souls of the participants in the crime, that they will be internally convicted of their inhumane treatment of others and disregard for basic human life."

### In U.K., care denied for premature baby

**WASHINGTON (BP)**--A young British mother says her prematurely born son was left to die last October by doctors because he fell two days short of the minimum requirement for care.

Sarah Capewell's son, Jayden, was born 21 weeks and five days into her pregnancy, but physicians said he needed to be at 22 weeks gesta-

tion in order to be treated, she told The Daily Mail in a Sept. 9 article. He lived for nearly two hours without medical assistance. She is seeking a review of the guidelines followed by National Health Service (NHS) hospitals in such cases.

Jayden, who was born at an NHS hospital in Norfolk, was breathing without help, had a strong heart rate and was moving his arms and legs after his birth, said Capewell, 23.

She told The Daily Mail she pleaded with a pediatrician, saying, "You have got to help." The doctor said, "No we don't"

While she was having contractions, a chaplain visited her to make plans for a funeral for her yet-to-be-born son, Capewell said. "I was sitting there, reading this leaflet about planning a funeral and thinking, this is my baby, he isn't even born yet, let alone dead," she said, according to the newspaper.

## FTC orders Daniel Chapter One to lie to customers about cancer remedies

(NaturalNews) The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) is at war with online retailers of nutritional supplements and natural remedies, but it recently lost a major battle: **Lane Labs**, which has suffered under FTC and FDA tyranny for years, recently won a significant battle against the corrupt agency. After the FTC tried to sue Lane Labs for \$24 million, claiming "contempt of court" for the company telling the truth about the efficacy of its products, a federal judge ruled against the FTC, explaining that Lane Labs was telling the scientifically-validated truth about its products when it described their health benefits.

This defeat of the FTC's latest attempt to censor the truth about nutritional supplements is making waves in the nutrition industry. It signals a crack in the wall of FTC tyranny and a possible route for establishing Free Speech for nutritional supplement companies that only seek to tell the truth about their products.

In the world of truth-telling, no one speaks the truth about natural remedies more openly and honorably than a small company called **Daniel Chapter One** ([www.DanielChapterOne.com](http://www.DanielChapterOne.com)), a religious ministry that also sells anti-cancer herbs, many of which are advocated in the Bible and other religious writings. Supported by a radio show and a website, Daniel Chapter One dares to tell people the truth about its natural remedies, even in the face of extreme intimidation and threats from the FTC.

The FTC is demanding that Daniel Chapter One *lie to all its customers* by signing and distributing a document claiming their natural cancer remedies do not work. That same document would also direct customers to the National Cancer Institute -- a pro-Pharma government group engaged in widespread scientific fraud and public disinformation cam-

paigns (the NCI runs ads warning people to avoid all sunlight, for example, promoting widespread vitamin D deficiencies).

**Daniel Chapter One needs your support**, and it's an organization worth fighting for. They are, in essence, taking point position on a very dangerous mission, working to break the FTC's iron grip and restore Free Speech rights to the entire industry. Although Jim and Trish have been threatened with imprisonment, having their products confiscated, having their ministry raided and shut down and being fined millions of dollars, they have held firm in their belief that **telling the truth about medicinal herbs is their God-given right**.

Today, Daniel Chapter One finds itself embattled against the federal government, standing virtually alone in an industry where most companies are too intimidated to stand up for their own rights. To help promote health freedom, they've launched another website called Daniel Chapter One Freedom (<http://danielchapteronefreedom.com>), and I encourage you to join their email newsletter on that site. Write your representatives in Washington, too, to insist that the FTC end their attempts to silence and intimidate not just Daniel Chapter One but other nutritional supplement companies as well.

The FTC's attack on Daniel Chapter One is more than just an assault on Free Speech, by the way: It's also an assault on *religious freedom*. The organization is a ministry, after all, but that hasn't stopped the FTC from threatening to imprison its founders.

Recently, Daniel Chapter One issued an important press release, reprinted here in full for you to read:

### Announcement from Daniel Chapter One

**Bureaucratic Assault on Freedom:** On Aug. 5, 2009, after a preliminary hearing in Washington DC, the FTC judge ruled against the small ministry, charging Daniel Chapter One with "violation of the FTC Act", which states that pharmaceutical drugs ONLY can claim to be of benefit for any particular health condition. pharmaceutical industry -- not the American consumer seeking helpful health information. No historical knowledge, consumer experience, or traditional practice satisfies FTC demands. Only the label of drug satisfies FTC demands. Dietary supplements, including herbs and nutrients, are not drugs.

In 23 years, Daniel Chapter One has never had a single complaint that their products or information harmed any one in any way, but rather, thousands have claimed that they have helped. A total of 5 Expert Witnesses, professionals renowned in their field of Science, Naturopathy, and Herbology, each testified that there is substantial scientific evidence for the health

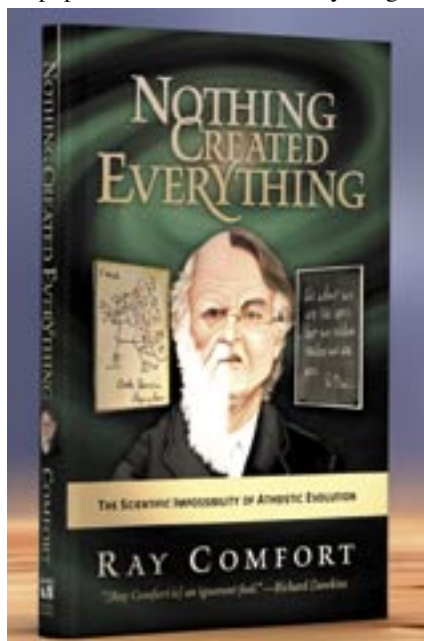

The author, who hosts an award-winning television program, with actor Kirk Cameron, said, "All you have to do is present unbiased facts about the unscientific and unthinking nature of atheistic evolution, and then watch people change their minds (we have a number of professing atheists do that on camera). And when God is brought back into their worldview, they think about

the importance of living in regard to moral absolutes. Evolution says that there is no absolute right or wrong, and that human beings are nothing but meaningless animals. God says that we have worth, and that there is absolute right and wrong. That changes everything."

scendo following months of bad news coming out of our country's capitol, my husband and I made the momentous decision to be in the number who would, on Saturday, September 12, 2009, protest the hijacking of America by attending the March on Washington. We cut down on our expenses by driving (10 hours there, 8 hours back) and by arranging a thoroughly enjoyable overnight visit with relatives in northern Virginia. It was from them that we learned about busses being chartered by the VA Tea Party to go into D. C., thus saving us the hassle of parking and trying to

Leaving Rhode Island mid-afternoon on Friday, we arrived in Virginia around 1:00 a. m. on Saturday but we couldn't sleep for long, as we needed to get up early to catch the 8:15 a. m. bus into D. C. Saturday dawned sunny and warm with gentle, cooling breezes. Yet as the day wore on, we noticed grey storm clouds beginning to gather over Washington, mercifully shielding the assembling crowd from the hot sun, and lingering protectively throughout the three hour rally. Despite weather forecasts which had warned of scattered thundershowers, the threatening clouds served only to bless us, for not a drop of water rained on our parade (or rally) the entire time.

later at the March on Washington. Along the way they held rallies in 33 cities, calling attention to some of the "worst offenders in Congress who have voted for higher spending, higher taxes, and government intervention in the lives of American families and businesses." They held rallies in CA, NV, AZ, NM, TX, AR, TN, KY, IN, IL, MI, OH, PA, NY, CT, and NJ. While wending their way towards Washington, D. C., they put out a call for people to greet them as they came into the city, and expected maybe 50 or 100 would be on hand. Imagine their surprise when 2,000 smiling and waving fellow patriots welcomed their tired band of fellow conservatives who had provided such terrific publicity throughout the country in support of the March.

lie!," "USA", "Pelosi has to go", and "Enough! Enough!" Several marchers were dressed in colonial costumes and carried signs bearing quotes from our Founding Fathers. One moving float bearing singers and a sound system entertained passing marchers midway down Pennsylvania Avenue.

Throughout the day, a determined but upbeat and even joyful mood prevailed among all the marchers who were jostled together in close proximity as they moved down Pennsylvania Avenue and later found themselves jammed together for three hours at the Rally site. Unintentionally jabbed by signs, stepped on, and pushed, good-natured fellow Americans demonstrated remarkable patience and courtesy to the strangers surrounding them with such comments as "sorry", "no problem", "excuse me", "that's okay", "you couldn't help it", "don't worry about it", "love your sign!", "can you believe this?!", "where are you from? (do you know so-and-so?)", "thank you", "you're welcome", and "God bless you".

Responding to a veritable cre-

As our bus neared D. C., we became aware of many other busses headed in the same direction, some festooned with banners revealing their destination/mission. The city of Washington had issued over 4,500 bus permits for that Saturday. Our bus arrived about 10:00 a. m., well ahead of the 11:30 start time for the mile-long March which would begin at Freedom Plaza (1350 Pennsylvania Avenue) and end at the US Capitol West Front Lawn. After the March, a three hour rally was scheduled for 1:00 p. m.

About 10:30 a.m., those on our bus began the 20 minute walk up 14th Street and over to the starting point of the March on Pennsylvania Avenue. We had thought we would have to wait to begin marching if we showed up before the official start time of 11:30, but after we saw the size of the crowds descending upon our location, we dared not stay any longer on the bus. We were surrounded on every side by swarms of people, and pushed along a bit faster than we might have liked, but at that point there was no holding back. However when we reached Freedom Plaza, well before 11:00 a. m., we were startled to find that there would be no wait to start marching -- the March had already begun! Since there was no place to put the crowds, the Capitol Police had been forced to let everyone just keep going, and for more than three hours Pennsylvania Avenue was completely swamped with elbow-to-elbow marchers on their way to the Rally site a mile away.

There was never a hint of violence and, surprisingly, no sign of opposition either, despite many pre-March threats. (Also noteworthy and in stark contrast to the pictures we'd seen of literally tons of trash left behind following President Obama's Inauguration last January, we saw no trash whatever when we returned to our bus following the March on Washington.)

As we approached the Mall for the Rally, we saw a long bank of perhaps 75 porta-potties with lengthy lines of 50 to 75 desperate-looking people stretching out from each one. One woman informed us that she had been waiting there an hour. Trying to find a spot to sit down for the rally was our next challenge. The people on our bus had wisely divided into small groups of three or four with leaders for each, and exchanged cell phone numbers in case we should become separated at the rally. Once we arrived at the Rally site it was bedlam, and practically impossible to keep together in the crowd or find one another except

From our vantage point, still on the bus at 10:00 a. m., we could observe thousands upon thousands of people streaming in from every direction, all carrying signs and/or American flags and yellow "Don't Tread On Me" flags. As far as the eye could see, a sea of humanity was converging on the capitol. The crowds spanned the spectrum of all ages and conditions, from young mothers carrying babies in slings or pushing strollers, to elderly and disabled folk, some limping and struggling along on canes, some in self-propelled wheelchairs, and everyone carrying homemade signs or flags. Of particular interest to us was the large number of people in their thirties and forties, many with young families in tow. This effectively put the lie to the reports of the so-called "mainstream" media (which fast appear to be losing the privilege of such a designation), that endeavor to downplay the significance of this movement by reporting that it is comprised predominantly of "old people and veterans".

Among the late arrivals was an impressively large contingent of marchers who greeted and accompanied the Tea Party Express into the city. Starting out on August 28 from Sacramento, CA and slowly working its way east to Washington, D. C., the Tea Party Express finally arrived two weeks

by looking overhead for signs we might recognize. Numerous calls for missing persons could be heard over the loudspeakers but, happily, reunions were soon announced. Although many ended up standing, we finally found a spot to set down the heavy tote bag and the chairs-in-a-bag that we'd been lugging since 10:30. From where we landed we could not actually see the stage, but there were several large screens set up for those too far back to see it, and the audio system was excellent. Since the crowd was attentive, everything could easily be heard.

The Rally featured short-winded speakers interspersed with musical selections including an opportunity for all to join in singing "America the Beautiful", a thrilling experience in a crowd of that magnitude. Former House Majority Leader Dick Armey (R-TX), Representative Mike Pence (R-IN) who is Chairman of the House Republican Conference, Senator Jim DeMint (R-SC), and Representative Tom Price (R-GA) were the only "big names" who spoke, and none for longer than a couple of minutes each. Armey, who now leads FreedomWorks Foundation, a conservative organization that was among the several sponsors of the March, was not the only one who took aim at House Speaker Nancy Pelosi. He snapped a photo of the crowd, saying he wanted to prove to her that they were there and warned, "If it's necessary, we'll come back here next year."

Senator DeMint said he'd had enough of "Alice in Wonderland" politicians promising more programs at the risk of financial disaster. He added, "The president has warned us if we disagree with him he's going to call us out. Well, Mr. President, we are out!" Representative Mike Pence said Americans want health care reform but they don't want a government takeover. "Republicans, Democrats and independents are stepping up and demanding we put our fiscal house in order," Pence was quoted by the Associated Press. He continued, "I think the overriding message after years of borrowing, spending and bailouts is 'enough is enough'".

Other speakers included various Tea Party organizers from across the country who congratulated the marchers for leaving their comfort zones and coming so far to stand up and speak out about their serious concerns. They reported that every state in the country including Alaska and Hawaii was represented at the March. (Rhode Island Tea Party officials informed their members by e-mail that 1,100 had come from RI alone, and those numbers

did not include the many who hadn't registered for busses, but traveled on their own. Amazing -- and this from "blue state", liberal, overwhelmingly Democrat Rhode Island!)

About 4:00, as the Rally neared its end, we began the long trek back to our bus, and were gratified to see that even at that late hour the Reflecting Pool was still surrounded by concentric circles many people deep. As we left the area, the only person we ever saw who was opposed to our sentiments was a (courageous!) man standing all alone and dressed in a t-shirt sporting a picture of President Obama. He said to me, "I am a patriot, and I support President Obama's policies." I replied incredulously, "You DO?" and he said, "Yes, I do." We each smiled, parted, and that was that!

Inevitably after such an event, there are the usual arguments about just how big a crowd was there. In 1995, after organizers for the "Million Man March" threatened to sue the National Park Service for reporting the turnout for their event was only 400,000 when the organizers believed it had been 1.2 million,



Congress restricted the National Park Service from making crowd estimates. (This restriction was maintained for 14 years until being quietly lifted last January in time for President Obama's inauguration.) The Washington, D. C. Metropolitan Police Department also does not provide crowd estimates, and the Capitol police declined to comment.

However, estimates ranged from the ridiculously low "official" one of "60,000 to 75,000", provided by the Washington, D. C. Fire and Emergency Department, to "up to 2 million" originally estimated by the London Daily Mail but later revised to "as many as one million people", to the "1.5 million" estimated by the local affiliate of ABC News as reported by Senator Jim DeMint during his opening remarks at the Rally.

A rather sophisticated method of obtaining crowd estimates was used by Wizbang, whose blog displayed a fascinating 3.5 hour time-lapse image of the March. Wizbang's research concluded the crowd numbered between 500,000 and 1 million. Nationally syndicated radio talk show and Fox News TV host Glenn Beck said later that he'd heard

estimates closer to 1.7 million from the University of Illinois. Pajamas Media's Charlie Martin used several crowd-counting techniques to estimate a crowd of "probably well more than 850,000". Darla Dawold, Grassfire/ResistNet's National Coordinator, emphasized she couldn't be sure, but estimated "about one million". Although there was a wide divergence in estimates, one truth should now be evident to all: the conservative majority finally found its voice, and the conservative movement has now matured into the most significant political movement of the 21st century.

Saving the best for last, I hereby submit a list of some of the many handmade signs whose messages I was able to scribble down during the three hour Rally. As is obvious, the concerns of the crowd were many and wide-ranging: "I am the mob". "Resist socialism: 'chains' you can believe in!". "Feed ACORN to the squirrels". "The change I hoped for was freedom". "Recycle Congress". "Thank you, Glenn Beck. 1 Czar down, 32 to go". "Don't Tread On Me". "You are not entitled to what I have earned". "I love my country but I'm scared of my government". "Investigate ACORN". "Your fair share is NOT in my wallet". "Obamacare makes me sick". "I'm not your ATM". "Nurses Against Obamacare". "Abortion is not health care". "Undocumented worker" (under picture of Obama).

"Congress pack your bags, you're going home in 2010". "If you're not outraged, you're not paying taxes". "Next time, read the bill". "Bolsheviks promised change, too". "Latinos are conservative, too". "I had enough Socialism in the USSR". "I owe \$38,000" (carried by a 2 year old). "Go Green, Recycle Congress". "Climate Change: 2010". "For the first time in my life, I'm ashamed of my government". "Give me liberty, don't give me debt". "Can you hear us NOW?". "You can buy my clunker. You can't buy my vote". "Atlas, Shrug!". "We hired you, we'll fire you!". "Government is the problem, not the solution". "Born free, taxed to death". "Stop generational theft". "Read the Constitution! LIMITED government!". "Don't treat the symptoms, cure the disease!". (Carried by teenager): "Only 16 and in debt for \$9 trillion". "Don't worry, Comrade Obama knows what we need". (Held by a child): "Obama is stealing my future". "O. B. A. M. A.: One Big Awful Mistake America". "If the Constitution were the law of the land, then this Congress would be in jail!". "Save Capitalism! Stop Communism!". "America! God shed His Grace on thee". "Women deserve better than abortion". "Senator Bayh: I'm speaking, are you listening?". "It's your first year and we're already this mad!". "USA motto: In God we trust; in government, not \$o much". "SEIU: Thugocracy". "Cash for Caskets: Cap and Tax?". "Leave my healthcare alone!". Stop rewarding failure!". "What's a Czar? Where are we, Russia?". "Socialism: your taxes working for those who won't". "Idea: I pay for MY healthcare, you pay for YOURS!". "Debt + debt = debt. Do the math!".

"How's that change thing working for you?". "You can't spend your way out of debt. Stop your socialist agenda now!". " 'Entitlement' is not in the Constitution". "Fire Pelosi". "I love my country but I fear my elected officials." "Trust the Government with your Life? Vote no on universal healthcare". "We will not be silent!". "Kick the Radicals out! Investigate the crooks". "God only asks for ten percent!". "Obama is a fraud and a con man". "Little acorns grow up to be big Marxists". "Is it 2010 yet?". "Veteran of Cold War, Desert Storm, Libya, Panama. In summary, on 9/12 my husband and I walked in pride with a million (give or take) other Americans. They were not an "angry mob", nor "religious fanatics", nor a bunch of far-right radicals. Some were black, some Hispanic, most were white, and all were patriots. The news media, conspicuously absent, are now playing their usual games trying to downplay the numbers and/or significance of the event. But we who were eye witnesses to the March on Washington are of the opinion that this could be the Day That Changed America. Real change. Good change.

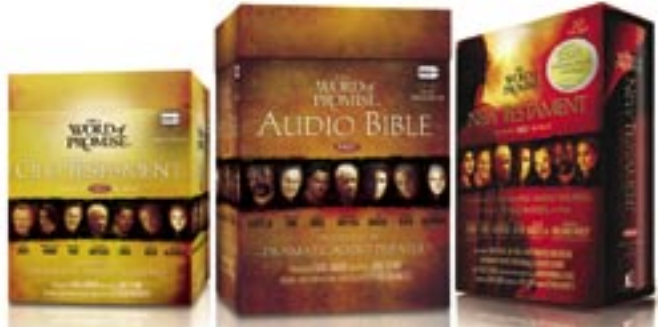

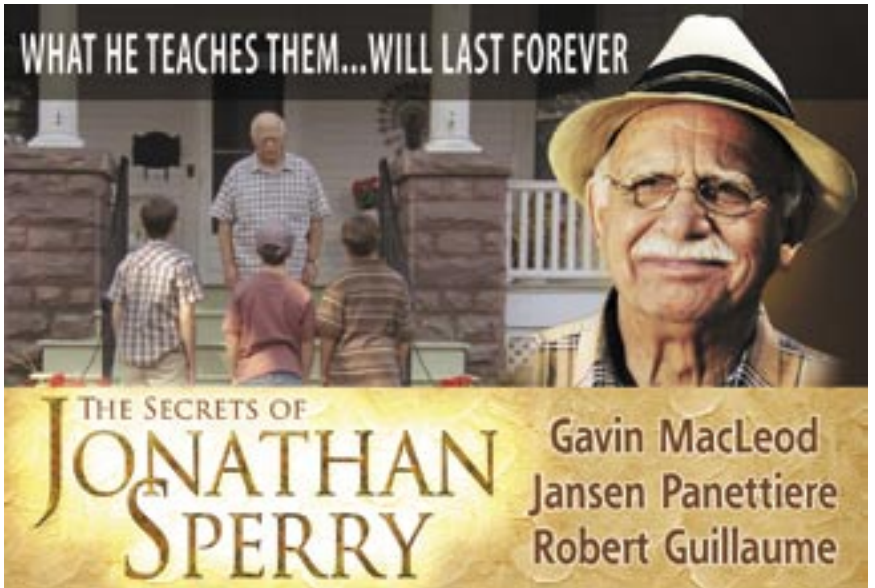

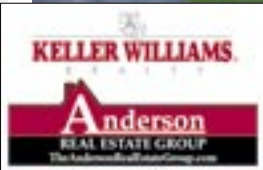

## John Harvard

Son of a butcher, his family died when a plague swept England, leaving him an estate. He attended Emmanuel College, was ordained, married and sailed for Massachusetts where he pastored the First Church of Charlestown. At age 31, he died of tuberculosis on SEPTEMBER 14, 1638. His name was Rev. John Harvard.

The College at Cambridge was renamed for Rev. Harvard. Fifty-percent of 17th-century graduates were ministers, as were 10 out of 12 of Harvard's presidents prior to the Revolution. Harvard's founders wrote:

"After God had carried us safe to New England, and we...rear'd convenient places for God's worship...dreading to leave an illiterate Ministry to the Churches, when our present Ministers shall lie in the Dust...it pleased God to stir up the heart of one Mr. Harvard, a godly gentleman and a lover of learning...to give the one half of his estate...towards the erecting of a college and all his Library."

As 106 of the first 108 schools in America were founded on Christianity, Harvard's Rules & Precepts stated September 26, 1642: "Let every Student be plainly instructed, and earnestly pressed to consider well, the main end of his life and studies is, to know God and Jesus Christ which is eternal life. John 17:3."

Last Wednesday the nation was riveted to the President's speech on healthcare reform before Congress. While the President's concern for the uninsured is no doubt sincere, his plan amounts to a magnanimous gift to the health insurance industry, despite any implications to the contrary.

The stipulation that pre-existing conditions would have to be covered seems a small price to pay for increasing their client pool to 100 of the American people. A big red flag, however, is that they would also

have immunity from lawsuits, should they fail to actually cover what they are supposedly required to cover, so these requirements on them are probably meaningless.

Mandates on all citizens to be customers of theirs, however, are enforceable with fines and taxes.

Insurance providers seem to have

successfully equated health insurance with health care but this is a relatively new concept. There were doctors and medicine long before there was health insurance. Health insurance is not a bad thing, but it is not the only conceivable way to get health care. Instead, we seem to still rely on the creativity and competence of politicians to solve problems, which always somehow seem to be tied in with which lobby is the strongest in Washington.

It is sad to think of the many creative, free market solutions that government prohibits with all its interference. What if instead of joining a health insurance plan, you could buy a membership directly from a hospital or doctor? What if a doctor wanted to have a cash-only practice, or make house calls, or determine his or her own patient load, or otherwise practice medicine outside the constraints of the current bureaucratic system? Alternative healthcare delivery models will be at an even stronger competitive disadvantage if families are forced to buy into the insurance model. And yet, the reforms are sold to us as increasing competition.

What if just once Washington got out of the way and allowed the ingenuity of the American people to come up with a whole spectrum of alternatives to our broken system? Then the free market, not lobbyists and politicians, would decide which models work and which did not.

Unfortunately, the most broken aspect of our system is that Washington sees the need to act on every problem in society, rather than staying out of the way, or getting out of the way. The only tools the government has are force and favors. These are tools that many unscrupulous and lazy corporations would like to wield to their own advantage, rather than simply providing a better product that people will willingly buy. It seems the health insurance industry will get more of those advantages very soon.

## The Virtual Adultery of Pornography

(CBN) Yesterday I had the chance to share on pastoral counseling and afterwards I was approached by a young woman who timidly asked me to give her a few minutes in private. Sensing an urgent need, I agreed and we stepped away to talk privately, though still in a public setting, and prayed for the Lord to give us wisdom.

She is a young woman married to a minister of the Gospel, who accidentally discovered two years ago that her husband is involved in pornography. She confronted him, but he keeps falling into sin and refuses to confess to anyone, insisting that he can overcome this on his own. Recently she even found pornographic images on the computer at church! and films that he's purchased. She has tried to help him by working near him so that he feels being observed, but he insists on using the lap-top alone. Then she told him that he cannot continue to preach while in this habitual sin, to which he retorted that placing a "block" on his computer was enough; but she fears that without having confessed his sins to anyone, he would continue on his sinful ways while being accountable to no one.

It is hard to describe how a woman feels when she discovers her husband has a secret and sordid life and has cheated on her for years. She feels betrayed, used, ashamed and even disgusted at his touch. Their marital bed has been sullied, and she loses respect for him, questions his authority and thus struggles to accept it. This wife does not want to leave her husband and fears that by denying his embrace she will further push him down the path of his destructive habit. But as a Christian, she also knows that he cannot continue to minister the Word of God while living a lie and placing other believers under the influence of his lie. She asked him to leave the ministry and seek help but he refused. What should a woman do in this case? she asked me.

I told her there are three dimensions to her case with different priorities: first, the spiritual life of her husband is in danger; secondly, the sheep under his care and thirdly, his own marriage is in grave danger. Her husband is offending God, deceiving his flock, and breaking their marriage covenant because looking at a woman lustfully is adultery- even virtual images of a woman. If he could see the situation in this way, it would help him not to act on the natural impulse of self-protection, but rather to see this as an instrument of God and a healing agent for man, for the Kingdom and for his own marriage.

It is very difficult for a woman, but when life is endangered it is neces-

sary for her to take authority over her fallen husband. Her husband has a form of cancer that needs to be treated radically for their own good, and as no effort is spared in the case of a physical illness, the same should apply to this spiritual case. A wolf (i.e. the adversary) has gotten into the flock which requires the authorities to be alerted, and the only hope for their marriage is to appeal to the mercy of God to heal him completely. She is not obliged to give her body to her unfaithful husband, but out of love, she is to give him every opportunity to be healed and restored. Ideally, he would recognize his sin and confess them to their authorities and receive their necessary discipline, monitoring and restoration as a man, as a husband and possibly even as a minister.

There is no guarantee that he will allow himself to be healed and the process will surely bring with it stress and discomfort, but it is worth fighting for the man she loves. If her husband confesses, she is to treat him as a sick man in need of support, and she is to accompany him all the way along the road to healing. But if he does not confess, then she has no choice but to report him to the authorities and treat him like a criminal who falls into the hands of the law, and then faithfully await while he "serves his sentence."

I ask the reader to pray for this wife facing such a hard (and sadly common) situation.

## BIBLE SCENE MUGS *MINISTRY TIP*

To make Bible Scene Mugs you need: Bibles and Bible concordances, newspaper, white paper, markers, white coffee mugs, small paint brushes and various colors of enamel paint.

Ask your students to use their Bibles and concordances to find a favorite Bible story they would like to illustrate on a mug. Allow time for each child to share his or her favorite story and the moral.

Ask your young people to draw their Bible story, including the reference, onto a piece of white paper with markers. Review each drawing and provide assistance as needed.

Cover the table with newspaper to protect it. Distribute white mugs, brushes and enamel paint to your students. Assist the children as they transfer their Bible scene from their papers to their mugs. When your young people have finished painting, carefully place

the mugs in a safe location on newspaper. Explain that it will take a long time for enamel paint to dry, and that they can pick up their mugs after class the following week. However, they can take their drawings home right away to share with their parents.

A week later, the children can take home their beautiful piece of artwork which will remind them of their favorite Bible story! The Bible Scene Mugs also make wonderful gifts for family members.

## Not Too Early; Never Too Late!

“Abraham and Sarah were already old and well advanced in years.” (Genesis 18:11) “Don’t let anyone look down on you because you are young.” (1 Timothy 4:12)

Age isn’t related to important achievements. Maturity, yes. Attitude, absolutely. Skill and intelligence, of course. But not age. Benjamin Franklin, already a successful publisher, inventor, diplomat and signer of the Declaration of Independence, led the convention that drafted the Constitution of the United States. He was eighty-four. A few years earlier, about the time Franklin was signing the Declaration, Mozart was living in Salzburg, having just completed all five of his violin concertos, each one a masterpiece. He was twenty. Age had no bearing on that summer of significant moments.

Some time ago I interviewed a young man seeking a job. At nineteen he lacked spirit, the fire within—if there had ever been one—just an ember. The same day I spoke to a new friend, age eighty-seven, whose voice was alive, eyes shining, energy directed toward what was next. Age is irrelevant. Attitude is everything. Trying, not giving up, caring enough to use the resources we’ve been given—these are the things that matter.

So William Gladstone at eighty-



five was prime minister of England and the world’s leading statesman. At seventeen Elizabeth Barrett (Browning) published a volume of

serious poetry. Galileo was dictating records of his latest discoveries about the rotation of planets (and hiding them in his mattress in order to avoid punishment as a heretic) when he was seventy-eight. Michelangelo began painting the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel in his early thirties.

Insight, determination and genius are not limited by age.

Martin Luther was thirty-four

when he walked to the door of the castle church in Wittenburg, Germany and posted there the ideas for change he wanted to debate with Church leaders. Abraham, founder of the Hebrew nation at the age of one hundred, might have smiled at how one so young could do something so important while Timothy, at twenty-six the leader of one of the largest Christian churches of the first century, might have wondered what had taken Martin so long.

Beethoven had composed a pro-

digious quantity of music by the time of his death at fifty-six, while Grandma Moses, the famous 20th century folk artist, didn’t take up painting until she was seventy-five.

Golf prodigy Michelle Wie turned professional at fifteen, the same summer as my father-in-law, age ninety, made his first hole-in-one.

We’re not too young to do something significant. And we’re never too old.

## Halloween - Saved from the Occult

Ching.” I learned to see and read a person’s aura, or that person’s life force. I also learned how to change that aura and to impose my will on that person. I had out-of-body trips during which my soul would leave my physical body and would travel wherever I chose and witness the things that I chose to see. I could read another person’s mind and I could project my thoughts into that person in an effort to control them and to accomplish the things that I wanted. Instead of telling my friends about last night’s séances and out-of-body experiences, I want to tell them about Jesus, and His love for them. Instead of celebrating the Vigil of Samhain, or Halloween, I celebrate Christ, the one and true God of life.

Now, on a sad note, every year our city and our land will celebrate this Vigil to Samhain. They will decorate their homes and businesses with black cats and pumpkins. They will hang pictures of ghosts and goblins about their houses and offices. Witches and broomsticks will be seen every where you turn. Parents will send their children out into the streets of the community to go house to house begging gifts.

What is even more disheartening are the many churches, Bible-believing and God-honoring churches, that will also decorate their halls with trappings of this day. Ghosts and goblins will share the same wall with the Cross of Christ. Witches with broomsticks

and black cats will be seen next to Bible verses telling of the love of God. Right here in our own town a church-sponsored daycare hung cobwebs from the ceilings, and black spiders that crawled up the walls. A skeleton greeted you as you walked through the door and a witch will bid you farewell as you left. All of this happened because Halloween is supposedly an innocent holiday that is no longer the evil day it once was.

How can we as believers ever hope to turn this world toward Christ if we continue to give honor to the devil? How can we speak out against the evil of our day when we Christians depict the things of this evil on the walls of our churches, in our home, and in our businesses? What will we say to our Lord when He holds us accountable for the souls that were lost because we never spoke out?

The Word of God tells us in Deuteronomy 18:10-12:

“There shall not be found among you anyone that maketh his son or daughter to pass through the fire, or that worketh divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter or a witch or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. For all that do these things are an abomination to the Lord.”

And in Leviticus 20:6 we are told, “And the soul that turneth after such as have familiar spirits and after wizards to go a whor-

ing after them, I will set my face against that soul and will cut him off from among his people.”

Paul tells us in Galatians 5 that witchcraft is one of the sins of the flesh and in verse 21 he tells us that they which do such things will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

Cleaning your house while your kids are still growing is like clearing the driveway before it has stopped snowing.

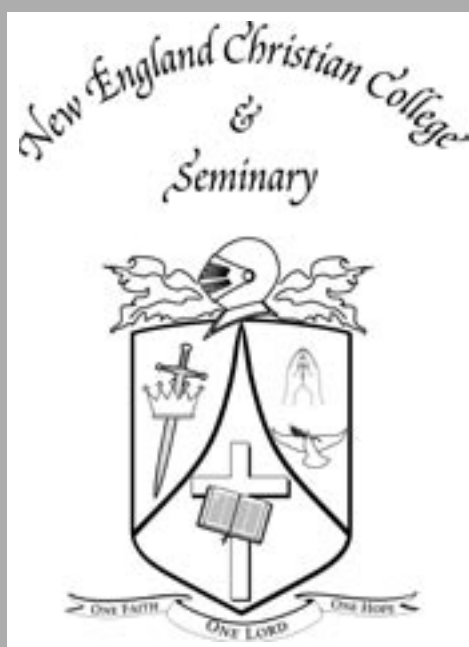

tion.” If they keep hyping this “pandemic,” mass hysteria and fear (created by the government and its lackeys in the media) will result. This would, no doubt, necessitate some form of forced vaccination, quarantine (maybe this is what all those internment camps will be used for), and martial law.

You know, like America’s Founding Fathers did 233 years ago.
